INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your Philips Audio BT2003 Portable Bluetooth Speaker. Please read these instructions carefully before using the device and retain them for future reference.

PRODUCT FEATURES

The Philips Audio BT2003 speaker is designed for portability and versatile audio playback.

- **Compact and Lightweight Design:** Weighing only 140 grams, it is easy to carry.
- **Carrying Strap:** For enhanced portability, allowing attachment to bags or wrists.
- **3W Sound Output:** Delivers clear audio for personal listening.
- **Multi-Connectivity:** Supports Bluetooth 5.0, USB Type-C, Audio-in (AUX), and MicroSD card playback.
- **Built-in Microphone:** Enables hands-free phone calls.
- **Rapid Charging:** USB Type-C port allows for quick battery replenishment.
- **FM Radio:** Integrated FM tuner for radio listening.

SETUP

1. Charging the Speaker

1. Connect the supplied USB Type-C cable to the charging port on the speaker.
2. Connect the other end of the USB cable to a compatible USB power adapter (not included) or a PC USB port.
3. The charging indicator light will illuminate during charging and turn off when fully charged.
4. A full charge takes approximately 45 minutes and provides up to 3 hours of playback time.

2. Powering On/Off

- To power on, press and hold the power button until the indicator light illuminates.
- To power off, press and hold the power button again until the indicator light turns off.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the speaker is powered on. The Bluetooth indicator light will flash, indicating it's in pairing mode.
2. On your device (smartphone, tablet, laptop), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
3. Select "Philips BT2003" from the list.
4. Once paired, the Bluetooth indicator light will stop flashing and remain solid.
5. You can now play audio wirelessly from your device.

Hands-Free Calling

- When connected via Bluetooth, the built-in microphone allows you to answer phone calls directly through the speaker.
- Press the call button (often indicated by a phone icon) to answer or end a call.

Audio-in (AUX) Connection

- Connect one end of the 3.5mm stereo line-in cable to the AUX port on the speaker.
- Connect the other end to the audio output jack of your external audio device.
- The speaker will automatically switch to AUX mode.

MicroSD Card Playback

- Insert a MicroSD card with audio files into the designated slot on the speaker.
- The speaker will automatically detect the card and begin playing music.

FM Radio

- Switch the speaker to FM radio mode (refer to the quick install guide for specific button functions).
- Use the control buttons to scan for and select radio stations.

Controls

The speaker features several control buttons:

- **Power Button:** Press and hold to turn on/off.
- **Play/Pause Button:** Press to play or pause music.
- **Volume Up/Next Track:** Short press for next track, long press for volume up.
- **Volume Down/Previous Track:** Short press for previous track, long press for volume down.
- **Mode Button:** To switch between Bluetooth, AUX, MicroSD, and FM modes.
- **Call Button:** To answer or end phone calls.

MAINTENANCE

- Clean the speaker with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Avoid exposing the speaker to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, or moisture.
- Store the speaker in a cool, dry place when not in use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
Speaker does not turn on.	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect to a power source using the USB Type-C cable.
Cannot pair via Bluetooth.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Ensure the speaker is in pairing mode (flashing Bluetooth indicator).◦ Make sure Bluetooth is enabled on your device.◦ Move the speaker closer to your device.◦ Forget "Philips BT2003" from your device's Bluetooth list and try pairing again.
No sound or low volume.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Adjust the volume on both the speaker and your connected device.◦ Ensure the correct input mode (Bluetooth, AUX, MicroSD) is selected.◦ Check if the audio cable is securely connected (for AUX mode).
Poor FM radio reception.	Reposition the speaker to improve signal reception.
