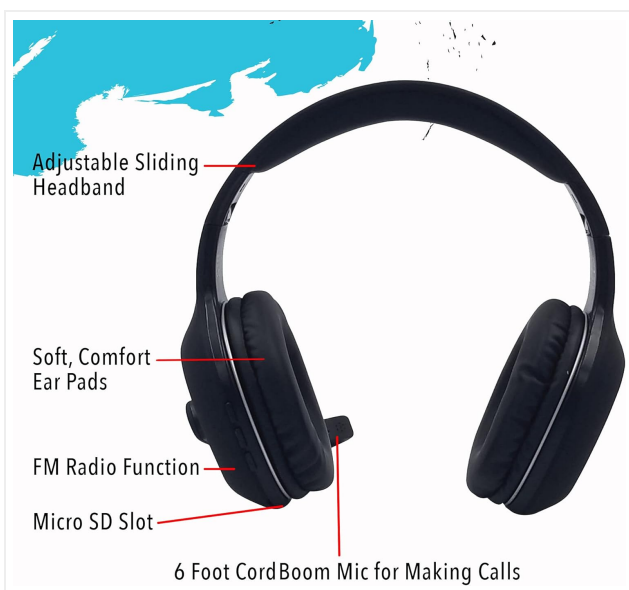

SETUP

Charging the Headphones

Before first use, fully charge the headphones. Connect the supplied USB charging cable to the charging port on the headphones and the other end to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter). The LED indicator will show the charging status and turn off or change color when fully charged. A full charge provides up to 10 hours of battery life.

Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the headphones are turned off.

2. Press and hold the Power button on the headphones until the LED indicator flashes blue and red, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, computer), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "Maxell 199342" or a similar name from the list of found devices.
5. Once connected, the LED indicator will turn solid blue or flash blue slowly.
6. If prompted for a password, enter "0000".

OPERATING

Controls

- **Power Button:** Press and hold to turn on/off. Press briefly to play/pause music or answer/end calls.
- **Volume Up (+):** Press to increase volume. Press and hold for next track.
- **Volume Down (-):** Press to decrease volume. Press and hold for previous track.
- **Boom Microphone:** Adjustable for optimal voice pickup during calls.

Making and Receiving Calls

- **Answering a Call:** When a call comes in, press the Power button once.
- **Ending a Call:** During a call, press the Power button once.
- **Rejecting a Call:** Press and hold the Power button for 2 seconds.
- **Redialing Last Number:** Double-press the Power button.

Music Playback

- **Play/Pause:** Press the Power button once.
- **Next Track:** Press and hold the Volume Up (+) button.
- **Previous Track:** Press and hold the Volume Down (-) button.

Wired Mode

The headphones can be used in wired mode even if the battery is depleted. Simply connect the included 3.5mm audio cable to the headphone's audio jack and the other end to your audio source. In wired mode, Bluetooth functionality and the boom microphone may not be active, depending on the device and cable connection.

FM Radio Function

To use the built-in FM radio, ensure the headphones are powered on. Press the 'M' button (Mode button, if present, or refer to specific button on your model) to switch to FM radio mode. Use the volume buttons to scan for stations. For better reception, extend the boom microphone or move to an open area.

Micro SD Slot

Insert a Micro SD card (not included) with your favorite music files into the designated slot. The headphones will automatically switch to Micro SD playback mode. Use the playback controls (Power button for play/pause, Volume buttons for track navigation) to manage your music.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the headphones. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

- **Storage:** Store the headphones in a cool, dry place when not in use. Avoid direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the headphones regularly, even if not in use for extended periods.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Headphones do not turn on.	Ensure the headphones are charged. Connect to a power source and try again.
Cannot pair with device.	Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (flashing blue/red). Turn off and on Bluetooth on your device. Move headphones closer to the device.
No sound or low volume.	Check volume levels on both headphones and connected device. Ensure headphones are properly paired. If in wired mode, check cable connection.
Microphone not working.	Ensure the boom microphone is properly positioned. Check microphone settings on your connected device.
Intermittent connection.	Move closer to the connected device. Avoid obstacles between headphones and device. Reduce interference from other wireless devices.
