NTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Night Owl 1080p HD Wired Indoor/Outdoor Add-On Cameras. These cameras are designed to enhance your existing Night Owl security system by providing high-definition video surveillance with advanced features such as Human Detection and Facial Capture. For optimal performance, please read these instructions carefully before installation and use.

1. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning installation, please verify that all components are present in your package:

- 2 x 1080p Wired Cameras
- 1 x Camera Power Adapter
- 1 x 4-Way Camera Power Splitter
- 2 x 60 ft Video/Power Cables
- Mounting Hardware and Screws

2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

2.1 Compatibility Note

These cameras are specifically designed for use with Night Owl VDP2, DP2, and DP8 series recorders. They are not backward compatible with other Night Owl wired products. A compatible Night Owl recorder (sold separately) is required for camera operation and recording.

2.2 Connecting the Cameras

Follow these steps to connect your cameras to a compatible Night Owl Digital Video Recorder (DVR):

- 1. **Positioning:** Choose a suitable location for each camera. These cameras are weather-resistant and can be used both indoors and outdoors. Consider areas that provide a clear view of the desired surveillance zone.
- 2. **Cable Connection:** Connect one end of the 60 ft video/power cable to the camera. The cable has two connectors: a BNC connector for video and a power connector.

- 3. **Power Connection:** Use the 4-way camera power splitter to connect the power ends of the camera cables to the camera power adapter. Plug the camera power adapter into a power outlet.
- 4. **DVR Connection:** Connect the BNC video ends of the camera cables to the "WIRED CAMERAS" input ports on the back of your Night Owl DVR. Ensure a secure connection for both video and power.
- 5. **DVR Setup:** Refer to your Night Owl DVR's instruction manual for initial setup, network configuration, and camera detection.


3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Remote Viewing and Playback

Once your cameras are connected to a compatible Night Owl recorder and the recorder is set up for network access, you can utilize the free Night Owl remote viewing app for iOS and Android Smart Devices. This app allows you to:

- View live camera feeds from anywhere.
- Access recorded footage for playback.
- · Receive real-time alerts.

There are no monthly fees for remote viewing. Ensure your recorder is connected to the internet for this feature to function.

3.2 Human Detection and Facial Capture

When used with a compatible Night Owl recorder, these cameras support advanced detection features:

- **Human Detection:** This technology helps reduce false alerts to your smart device by distinguishing human movement from other motion sources.
- Facial Capture: Upon detecting a person, the system can capture a snapshot of their face and send a real-time alert to your smart device. This allows you to quickly identify if the person is familiar or unfamiliar.

3.3 Night Vision and Color Night Vision

The cameras are equipped with advanced night vision capabilities:

- Color Night Vision: In low-light conditions, the cameras can continue to record in full color.
- Standard Night Vision: If light levels become too low for color night vision, the cameras automatically switch to infrared night vision, providing clear black and white video up to 100 feet.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning the Cameras

To ensure clear image quality, periodically clean the camera lens and housing. Use a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents that could damage the lens or finish.

4.2 Environmental Considerations

These cameras are weather-resistant (IP54 rated) and designed for both indoor and outdoor use. They can withstand moisture, dirt, and debris. However, for prolonged durability, avoid direct exposure to extreme weather conditions where possible, such as direct water jets or prolonged submersion.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Night Owl cameras, consider the following common troubleshooting steps:

· No Video Feed:

- Ensure all cables (video and power) are securely connected to both the camera and the DVR.
- Verify the camera power adapter is plugged into a working outlet.
- Confirm the camera is connected to a compatible Night Owl DVR (VDP2, DP2, or DP8 series).
- Check the DVR's settings to ensure the camera channel is enabled and configured correctly.

• Poor Night Vision:

- Ensure the camera lens is clean and free from obstructions.
- Check for any nearby reflective surfaces that might interfere with infrared illumination.
- Verify that the camera's night vision settings on the DVR are correctly configured.

• False Alerts (Human Detection):

Adjust the motion detection sensitivity settings on your DVR.

• Ensure the camera's field of view is clear of moving objects like tree branches or flags that could trigger false alerts.

• Remote Viewing Issues:

- Confirm your Night Owl DVR is connected to the internet.
- Check your home network connection and router settings.
- Ensure the Night Owl app on your smart device is updated to the latest version.
