- **Durable Construction:** The amplifier's edges are reinforced with hard material to protect against damage, and rubber pads ensure safe and stable placement.




Image: Close-up of the Donner M-10 control panel, highlighting the input jacks and control knobs.

3. SETUP AND GETTING STARTED

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the amplifier from its packaging. Inspect for any signs of damage.
- Power Connection: Connect the amplifier to a power source using the provided USB-C cable. The charging port is located on the rear panel. A red indicator light will show charging status, turning off when fully charged.
- 3. **Initial Placement:** Place the amplifier on a stable, flat surface. Ensure adequate ventilation around the unit.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. **Power On/Off:** Locate the power switch on the amplifier's control panel and switch it to the 'ON' position.
- 2. Connecting Your Instrument: Plug your electric guitar or bass into the 1/4" Instrument Input jack.
- 3. Adjusting Volume: Use the 'Volume' knob to control the overall output level of the amplifier.
- 4. Tone Shaping:
 - $\circ\,$ 'Gain' knob: Controls the amount of input signal, affecting the level of distortion.
 - 'Distortion Selection Switch': Toggle between clean and distorted tones.

- 'Treble', 'Midrange', 'Bass' knobs: Adjust the high, mid, and low frequencies of your tone.
- 5. **Using APP Effects:** Connect your mobile phone to the 1/8" TRRS guitar interface. Use compatible software effects applications (e.g., Amplitube, Deplike, Tone-bridge, Bias, TC Guitar Rack) to customize your sound.
- 6. **Auxiliary Input:** Connect an external audio device (e.g., MP3 player, CD player) to the 1/8" Auxiliary Input Jack to play along with backing tracks.
- 7. **Headphone Use:** For silent practice, plug headphones into the 1/8" Headphone Output Jack. This will mute the main speaker output.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|------------------------------|--|---|
| No sound output | Amplifier not powered on; Volume knob too low; Instrument cable faulty; Headphones plugged in. | Ensure power is on; Increase Volume; Check/replace instrument cable; Unplug headphones. |
| Distorted sound (unintended) | Gain knob too high; Distortion switch engaged; Faulty instrument/cable. | Reduce Gain; Disengage Distortion switch; Check instrument/cable. |
| APP effects not working | Phone not connected correctly; Incompatible APP; Software settings incorrect. | Ensure secure connection to 1/8" TRRS jack; Verify APP compatibility; Check APP settings. |
| Battery not charging | USB-C cable faulty; Power adapter faulty; Charging port damaged. | Try a different USB-C cable/power adapter; Contact customer support if issue persists. |
