SETUP

Initial Setup

- 1. Unpack all components from the box.
- 2. Place the Power Flosser unit on a stable, flat surface near an electrical outlet.
- 3. Fill the Power Flosser reservoir with water. Open the hinged lid and pour lukewarm water into the reservoir up to the MAX line. Close the lid.
- 4. Attach the desired nozzle (e.g., Quad Stream nozzle) to the Power Flosser handle.
- 5. Plug the Power Flosser into a power outlet.
- 6. Attach the brush head to the ExpertClean 7300 toothbrush handle.
- 7. Place the toothbrush on its charging dock to ensure it is fully charged before first use.

OPERATING THE POWER FLOSSER

Modes and Intensities

The Power Flosser offers 4 flossing modes and 10 intensity settings:

- Clean Mode: Standard cleaning.
- Deep Clean Mode: For a more intensive clean.
- Sensitive Mode: Gentle cleaning for sensitive gums.
- Gum Care Mode: Massages gums.

Adjust the intensity using the dial on the unit (settings 1-10).

Quad Stream Technology

The unique Quad Stream nozzle creates an X-shaped stream of water that covers a larger surface area, reaching deep between teeth and along the gum line.



Flossing Procedure

with string floss

- 1. Direct the X-shaped stream of water between teeth.
- 2. Move the Power Flosser along the gum line, allowing the Pulse Wave technology to guide you from tooth to tooth.
- 3. Ensure the nozzle is positioned at a 90-degree angle to the gum line.

OPERATING THE ELECTRIC TOOTHBRUSH

Modes

The ExpertClean 7300 offers various brushing modes for different needs:

- Clean: For daily cleaning.
- White: For surface stain removal.
- Gum Care: Gently massages gums.
- Deep Clean+: For an invigorating deep clean.

Brushing Procedure

Apply a small amount of toothpaste to the brush head. Place the brush head against your teeth at a slight angle towards the gum line. Press the power button to start. Gently glide the brush across your teeth, allowing the sonic vibrations to clean. The toothbrush will pause to indicate when to move to the next section of your mouth.

MAINTENANCE

Power Flosser

After each use, empty any remaining water from the reservoir. The reservoir can be removed for easy cleaning. Wipe the unit and handle with a damp cloth.

Toothbrush

Rinse the brush head and handle after each use. Store the brush head in the provided nozzle storage case. Store the toothbrush in a dry place. Replace brush heads every 3 months or sooner if bristles are frayed.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues

- **No water flow:** Ensure the reservoir is filled and the nozzle is correctly attached. Check for any blockages in the nozzle.
- Weak water pressure: Adjust the intensity dial to a higher setting.
- **Toothbrush not charging:** Ensure the charger is properly connected to the power outlet and the toothbrush is correctly placed on the charging base.
- Unusual noise: If the device makes unusual noises, discontinue use and contact customer support.
