## INTRODUCTION

The UPPAbaby PiggyBack Ride-Along Board is designed to enhance your strolling experience by allowing an older child to stand and ride along with a younger sibling in the stroller. This accessory provides a convenient solution for families with multiple young children, offering a comfortable and secure platform for your toddler when they need a break from walking.

**Compatibility:** This PiggyBack board is **ONLY COMPATIBLE** with UPPAbaby Cruz V2 and Cruz V3 strollers. It is **NOT COMPATIBLE** with Cruz Stroller (models 2019-older), Vista stroller (all models), Vista V2 stroller, Ridge stroller, Minu stroller, Minu V2 stroller, G-Luxe stroller (all models), or G-Link V2 stroller (all models).

# Transform Your Cruz

The PiggyBack easily attaches to the back of your Cruz V2 or Cruz V3 stroller to allow your older child to join in the stroll.

## SETUP

The PiggyBack board features an easy snap-on-and-off attachment system for quick installation and removal.

1. **Identify Attachment Points:** Locate the designated attachment points on the rear frame of your UPPAbaby Cruz V2 or Cruz V3 stroller. These are typically small, recessed areas designed to receive the PiggyBack connectors.
2. **Align Connectors:** Position the PiggyBack board behind the stroller. Align the connectors on the PiggyBack board with the attachment points on the stroller frame.
3. **Snap into Place:** Press firmly on both sides of the PiggyBack board until you hear an audible "click" from each connector. This indicates that the board is securely attached to the stroller frame. Gently tug on the board to ensure it is locked in place before use.

# OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## Using the Ride-Along Board

1. **Lowering the Board:** To deploy the PiggyBack board for use, press the single hand release button located on the board. The board will unlock and swing down into the use position.
2. **Child Placement:** Instruct your older child to stand on the non-skid surface of the board. Ensure they maintain a secure grip on the stroller's handlebar or frame for stability.
3. **Stroller Handlebar Adjustment:** For optimal comfort while pushing, adjust the stroller's handlebar to its highest position. This provides ample space for both the parent and the child on the board.

## Storing the Ride-Along Board

When the PiggyBack board is not in use, it can be conveniently lifted and locked out of the way.

1. **Lifting the Board:** Press the single hand release button and lift the board upwards. It will lock into an elevated position, keeping it out of the way.
2. **Folding the Stroller:** The UPPAbaby Cruz V2 and V3 strollers can be folded with the PiggyBack board attached. Ensure the board is in its locked-up position before folding the stroller for compact storage.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the wooden surface and non-skid area with a damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid harsh chemicals that may damage the material.
- **Wheel Inspection:** Regularly check the wheels for any debris, wear, or damage. Clean any accumulated dirt or hair from the wheel axles to ensure smooth operation.
- **Connection Points:** Periodically inspect the attachment points on both the PiggyBack board and the stroller frame for any signs of wear or damage. Ensure the quick release buttons function correctly.
- **Storage:** Store the PiggyBack board in a dry place when not in use for extended periods to prevent moisture damage to the wooden components.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Board Not Attaching Securely:**

- Ensure the PiggyBack board is compatible with your specific UPPAbaby Cruz V2 or V3 model.
- Check that the attachment points on the stroller frame are clear of obstructions and damage.
- Verify that both connectors on the PiggyBack board are properly aligned and pressed firmly until a click is heard.

- **Board Not Lifting/Lowering Smoothly:**

- Inspect the single hand release button/lever for any obstructions or damage.
- Ensure the mechanism is clean and free of dirt or debris.

- **Child Slipping on Board:**

- Confirm the non-skid surface is clean and dry.
- Ensure the child is wearing appropriate footwear with good grip.
- Remind the child to hold onto the stroller's handlebar for added stability.
