INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Pelonis 2-in-1 Turbo Heater and Fan. This versatile appliance is designed to provide both efficient heating during colder months and powerful air circulation during warmer periods. Its compact design and safety features make it an ideal solution for personal comfort in various indoor environments. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure safe and optimal operation.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury, observe the following:

- Read all instructions before using this heater/fan.
- This appliance is hot when in use. To avoid burns, do not let bare skin touch hot surfaces.
- Extreme caution is necessary when any heater/fan is used by or near children or invalids and whenever the heater/fan is left operating and unattended.
- Always unplug the heater/fan when not in use.
- Do not operate any heater/fan with a damaged cord or plug or after the heater/fan malfunctions, has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not run cord under carpeting. Do not cover cord with throw rugs, runners, or similar coverings. Arrange cord away from traffic area and where it will not be tripped over.
- To disconnect the heater/fan, turn controls to OFF, then remove plug from outlet.
- Do not insert or allow foreign objects to enter any ventilation or exhaust opening as this may cause an electric shock or fire, or damage the heater/fan.
- To prevent a possible fire, do not block air intakes or exhaust in any manner. Do not use on soft surfaces, like a bed, where openings may become blocked.
- A heater/fan has hot and arcing or sparking parts inside. Do not use it in areas where gasoline, paint, or flammable liquids are used or stored.
- Use this heater/fan only as described in this manual. Any other use not recommended by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury to persons.
- This heater/fan includes a tip-over safety switch. If the heater/fan is accidentally tipped over, it will automatically shut off. To reset, simply place the heater/fan upright.

SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the Pelonis 2-in-1 Turbo Heater and Fan from its packaging. Retain the packaging for future storage or transport.
2. **Placement:** Place the appliance on a firm, level surface. Ensure there is at least 3 feet (0.9 meters) of clear space around the front, back, and sides of the heater/fan to allow for proper air circulation and prevent overheating. Do not place it on soft surfaces like carpets or rugs that could block the air intake.
3. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord directly into a 120V AC, 60Hz electrical outlet. Avoid using extension cords or power strips, as they may overheat and create a fire hazard.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Pelonis 2-in-1 Turbo Heater and Fan features intuitive controls for easy operation.

1. **Power On/Off:** Plug the unit into a suitable electrical outlet. The power indicator light will illuminate when the unit is receiving power.
2. **Mode Selection:** Use the control knob on the top of the unit to select your desired mode:
 - **Fan Only:** Rotate the knob to the fan symbol for air circulation without heat.
 - **Low Heat:** Rotate the knob to the small flame symbol for low heat output.
 - **High Heat:** Rotate the knob to the large flame symbol for high heat output.
3. **Temperature/Speed Adjustment:** For models with a digital display, use the temperature control buttons (often indicated by a thermometer icon or 'M' for mode) to adjust the desired temperature. For models with a simple knob, the heat settings are fixed to low or high. Fan speed may also be adjustable depending on the model.

4. **Tip-Over Protection:** This unit is equipped with a safety switch at its base. If the heater/fan is accidentally knocked over, it will automatically power off. To resume operation, place the unit upright on a stable surface.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and efficient operation of your Pelonis 2-in-1 Turbo Heater and Fan.

- **Cleaning:**
 - Always unplug the appliance before cleaning.
 - Use a soft, damp cloth to wipe the exterior surfaces. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
 - Use a vacuum cleaner with a brush attachment to gently remove dust and debris from the air intake and exhaust grilles.
 - Do not immerse the heater/fan in water or allow water to drip into the interior.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the heater/fan in a cool, dry place. It is recommended to store it in its original packaging to protect it from dust and damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Pelonis 2-in-1 Turbo Heater and Fan, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Heater/Fan does not turn on.	Not plugged in, power outlet malfunction, tip-over switch activated, internal safety switch activated.	Ensure the unit is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check the tip-over switch at the base; ensure the unit is upright. If the unit overheated, unplug it, wait 30 minutes, and plug it back in.
No heat output.	Incorrect mode selected, thermostat set too low.	Ensure the unit is set to a heat mode (Low Heat or High Heat). Increase the thermostat setting if applicable.
Weak airflow.	Blocked air intake/exhaust, fan speed set too low.	Check for and remove any obstructions from the air grilles. Clean the grilles as per maintenance instructions. Increase the fan speed setting.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit makes unusual noise.	Dust or debris inside, loose components.	Unplug the unit and gently clean the grilles. If the noise persists, discontinue use and contact customer support.
