INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the Plantronics Voyager Focus UC B825 Bluetooth USB Headset. It covers product features, setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure optimal performance and user experience.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Headset Components

- **Earcups:** Padded earcups designed for comfort and effective sound isolation.
- **Microphone Boom:** A flexible boom equipped with multiple microphones for clear voice capture and dynamic noise reduction.
- **Headband:** An adjustable headband ensuring a secure and comfortable fit for various head sizes.
- **Controls:** Integrated buttons for call answer/end, volume adjustment, microphone mute, and Active Noise Cancellation (ANC) activation.

SETUP

Charging the Headset

Before initial use, ensure the headset is fully charged to maximize battery life.

1. Connect the USB charging cable to the charging stand or directly to the headset's charging port.
2. Plug the other end of the USB cable into a powered USB port (e.g., computer, USB wall adapter).
3. Place the headset onto the charging stand or ensure the cable is securely connected. The indicator light on the headset will display the charging status.

Pairing with Devices

The Voyager Focus UC B825 can connect to a PC/Mac using the included USB adapter and to mobile devices via Bluetooth.

Pairing with USB Adapter (PC/Mac)

1. Insert the USB Bluetooth adapter into an available USB port on your computer.
2. Power on your headset.
3. The adapter and headset are pre-paired from the factory and should connect automatically. The adapter's LED will turn solid blue when a connection is established.

Pairing with Mobile Device (Bluetooth)

1. With the headset powered on, slide and hold the Power switch towards the Bluetooth icon until you hear the voice prompt "pairing" and the headset LEDs flash red and blue.
2. On your mobile device, navigate to the Bluetooth settings and select "PLT Focus" from the list of available devices.
3. Once successfully paired, you will hear "pairing successful" and the headset LEDs will stop flashing.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Call Management

- **Answer/End Call:** Press the Call button located on the earcup.
- **Make a Call:** Initiate the call from your connected phone or softphone application.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the Call button for approximately 2 seconds.

Volume Control

Use the volume up (+) and volume down (-) buttons on the earcup to adjust the audio levels for calls and media.

Mute Function

Press the Mute button on the microphone boom to toggle your microphone's mute status.

The headset features a **Dynamic Mute Alert**: If you attempt to speak while your microphone is muted, an audible reminder will be provided.

Smart Mute: The headset can automatically mute your microphone when you remove it and unmute when you put it back on.

Active Noise Cancellation (ANC)

Slide the ANC switch on the earcup to activate or deactivate the active noise cancellation feature. ANC helps to reduce distracting background noise, enhancing your focus during calls or while listening to media.

Smart Sensor Technology

The headset incorporates smart sensors to detect when it is being worn or removed, enabling intelligent functionality:

- Removing the headset during an active call will mute the microphone. Placing it back on will unmute.
- Taking off the headset while listening to music will pause playback. Putting it back on will resume playback.

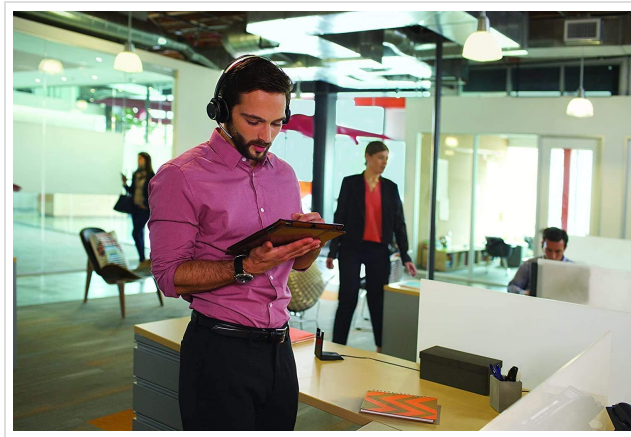


Image: A person wearing the Plantronics Voyager Focus UC B825 headset in a modern office setting, demonstrating its use for professional communication.

MAINTENANCE

- Keep the headset clean by gently wiping it with a soft, dry cloth.
- Avoid exposing the headset to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, excessive moisture, or corrosive substances.
- Store the headset in a cool, dry place when not in use to prolong its lifespan.
- Do not attempt to disassemble the headset, as this action will void the product warranty.

TROUBLESHOOTING

No Audio / Poor Audio Quality

- Ensure the headset is powered on and has sufficient battery charge.
- Verify that the headset is correctly paired and connected to your desired device (PC/Mac or mobile).
- Check and adjust the volume levels on both the headset and your connected device.
- If using the USB adapter, confirm it is securely plugged into a functional USB port on your computer.
- Restart your computer or mobile device and attempt to reconnect.

Microphone Not Working

- Ensure the microphone is not muted. Check the mute button and the status indicated by the Dynamic Mute Alert.
- Verify that the microphone boom is positioned correctly near your mouth for optimal voice pickup.
- Check the audio input settings on your computer or mobile device to confirm the headset is selected as the primary microphone.

Headset Not Pairing

- Ensure the headset is in pairing mode (LEDs flashing red and blue).
- Turn off and then on the Bluetooth function on your mobile device, then attempt the pairing process again.
- If pairing with a PC/Mac, confirm that the USB adapter is recognized and properly installed by the computer's operating system.
- Clear any previous Bluetooth connections on your device if you are experiencing persistent pairing issues.







