## INTRODUCTION

The eXuby Tiny Dual Shock Collar is designed to assist in training small dogs by providing sound, vibration, and static correction. This system allows for the training of two dogs simultaneously using a single remote, offering nine intensity levels for precise control. It features a compact design, long battery life, and water-resistant construction, making it suitable for various training environments. This product is intended for use with small dogs and is not recommended for cats.

For optimal results and the safety of your pet, please read this manual thoroughly before operating the device.

## PRODUCT FEATURES

- **Large Illuminated Screen:** Remote features a clear, illuminated display for easy readability day or night.
- **Easy Access Buttons:** Remote designed for quick and intuitive command execution.

## SETUP GUIDE

### 1. Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge both collar units and the remote control. Use the provided AC adapter and dual charging cord. The LED indicator on the collar will show charging status (typically red while charging, green when full). The remote's screen will indicate battery level.

### 2. Attaching Probes

Select the appropriate metal probes (long or short) based on your dog's fur length. Use the short probes for dogs with short fur and the long probes for dogs with thicker or longer fur. Screw the chosen probes firmly onto the collar unit. For added comfort and to prevent skin irritation, you may attach the rubber probe covers over the metal probes.

### 3. Assembling the Collar Strap

Thread the reflective vinyl strap through the plastic brackets on the collar unit. Adjust the strap to fit your dog's neck securely but comfortably. The collar should be snug enough for the probes to make consistent contact with the dog's skin, but not so tight as to cause discomfort or restrict breathing. You should be able to fit one or two fingers between the collar and your dog's neck.

#### 4. Pairing the Remote and Collars (if necessary)

The collars and remote are typically pre-paired from the factory. If pairing is lost or you need to re-pair, refer to the specific instructions in the included paper manual for your model (TZ-812). Generally, this involves turning on the collar, then pressing a pairing button on the remote or collar within a short timeframe.

### OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

#### Remote Control Functions

- **Power Button:** Press and hold to turn the remote ON/OFF.
- **Mode Button:** Cycles through correction modes: Sound (Beep), Vibration, and Static Correction. The selected mode will be displayed on the remote's screen.
- **Intensity Level Buttons (Up/Down Arrows):** Adjusts the intensity level for Vibration and Static Correction modes from 1 to 9.
- **Correction Buttons (Y/1/2):**
  - **Y Button:** Activates the selected correction mode (Sound, Vibration, or Static) on the currently selected collar (1 or 2).
  - **1/2 Button:** Toggles between controlling Collar 1 and Collar 2. The active collar number will be displayed on the remote's screen.

## Training Guidelines

This training collar is a tool to aid in behavior modification, not a substitute for proper training. It is not an automatic bark collar; manual input from the remote is required for corrections.

- **Start with Sound/Vibration:** Begin training with the sound or vibration modes. Many dogs respond well to these less intrusive corrections.
- **Introduce Static Correction Gradually:** If static correction is needed, start at the lowest intensity level and gradually increase until your dog responds with a noticeable reaction (e.g., twitching ears, looking around) but

without yelping or showing signs of pain. The goal is to get their attention, not to punish them.

- **Timing is Key:** Deliver the correction immediately as the unwanted behavior occurs. This helps your dog associate the correction with their action.
- **Positive Reinforcement:** Always pair corrections with positive reinforcement when your dog exhibits desired behavior. Reward them with praise, treats, or play.
- **Short Training Sessions:** Keep training sessions short and positive to prevent your dog from becoming stressed or overwhelmed.
- **Supervised Use:** Do not leave the collar on your dog for extended periods (more than 12 hours) or unsupervised.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning the Collar:** Regularly clean the collar unit and probes with a damp cloth. Ensure no dirt or debris accumulates around the probes, which could affect contact with the dog's skin.
- **Probe Inspection:** Periodically check the probes for wear or damage. Ensure they are securely attached.
- **Charging:** Recharge the collar units and remote when the battery indicator shows low power. Avoid completely draining the batteries to prolong their lifespan.
- **Storage:** Store the device in a cool, dry place when not in use.
- **Skin Health:** Inspect your dog's neck daily for any signs of irritation or sores from the probes. If irritation occurs, discontinue use until the skin heals and consult a veterinarian. Consider repositioning the collar or using different probe lengths.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Collar not responding to remote.	Low battery on collar or remote; Collar or remote is off; Not properly paired; Out of range; Poor contact with dog's skin.	Charge both devices fully. Ensure both are powered on. Re-pair if necessary (refer to paper manual). Move closer to your dog. Adjust collar fit to ensure probes make good contact.
Correction seems ineffective.	Intensity level too low; Probes not making good contact; Dog's fur is too thick for current probes.	Increase intensity level gradually. Ensure collar is snug. Use longer probes if your dog has thick fur.
Collar turns off accidentally.	Dog may be pressing the power button.	Ensure the collar is positioned correctly to prevent accidental button presses.
Battery drains quickly.	Frequent use; Aging battery; Not fully charging.	Ensure full charge cycles. If battery life significantly degrades, contact customer support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Skin irritation on dog's neck.	Collar too tight; Worn for too long; Probes causing pressure sores; Allergic reaction.	Loosen collar slightly. Do not leave on for more than 12 hours. Reposition collar frequently. Use rubber covers. Consult a veterinarian if irritation persists.




