INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the HOMIDEC 7-Tier Modular Shoe Rack. This product is designed to provide an efficient and customizable storage solution for your footwear and other items, capable of holding up to 28 pairs of shoes. Its modular design allows for flexible configuration to suit various spaces and needs, such as hallways, bedrooms, or entryways. Constructed from durable PP plastic panels with a metal frame and ABS connectors, this shoe rack offers stability and a clean aesthetic.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure all connectors are firmly secured during assembly to prevent instability.
- Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of 5 kg (11 lbs) per cube or 35 kg (77 lbs) total for the entire unit.
- Keep small components away from children to avoid choking hazards.
- Avoid placing the unit in direct sunlight or near heat sources to prevent material degradation.
- For added stability, especially if heavily loaded or in areas with children, consider anchoring the unit to a wall (anchoring hardware not included).

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps carefully to assemble your HOMIDEC 7-Tier Modular Shoe Rack. A hammer is provided to ensure all connections are secure.

Step 1: Plan Your Configuration

Before starting, decide on the desired layout for your shoe rack. The modular design allows for various arrangements. Consider the space available and the types of items you plan to store.

Step 2: Assemble the Base Cubes

Connect the plastic panels using the ABS connectors. Ensure that each panel is fully inserted into the connector slots. Use the provided hammer to gently tap the panels into place, ensuring a tight and secure fit. Start by building the base layer of cubes.

Step 3: Build Upwards

Continue adding layers of cubes, connecting them securely with the ABS connectors. Maintain alignment as you build. The unit is designed to be 7 tiers high in its standard configuration.

Step 4: Install Partition Panels and Doors

Insert the partition panels into the desired cubes to create two compartments for shoes. Attach the doors to the front of each cube using the designated connectors. Ensure the doors open and close smoothly.



Step 5: Attach Hooks

Utilize the included hooks by attaching them to the side of the assembled unit. These hooks are suitable for hanging umbrellas, keys, bags, or other small accessories.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The HOMIDEC shoe rack is designed for versatile storage. Here's how to maximize its use:

- **Shoe Storage:** Each cube, with its partition panel, can typically hold two pairs of standard shoes. Without the partition, a cube can accommodate taller items like boots or multiple pairs of smaller shoes. The entire 7-tier unit can store up to 28 pairs (56 shoes).
- **Multifunctional Use:** Beyond shoes, the cubes are suitable for storing clothes, accessories, bedding, books, toys, or other household items.
- **Customization:** The modular design allows you to reconfigure the cubes as needed. You can create different shapes or sizes by adding or removing cubes (additional cubes sold separately).
- **Door Operation:** Gently open and close the doors to access your stored items. The doors help keep contents dust-free and out of sight.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your shoe rack, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the plastic panels and connectors with a soft, damp cloth. For stubborn dirt, a mild soap solution can be used. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- **Dusting:** Regularly dust the unit to prevent accumulation, especially on the doors and internal surfaces.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all connections to ensure they remain secure. Re-tap with the hammer if any connections feel loose.
- **Avoid Overloading:** Do not place items heavier than the recommended 5 kg (11 lbs) per cube to prevent damage or collapse.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your HOMIDEC shoe rack, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Unit is unstable or wobbly:**
 - Ensure all plastic panels are fully inserted into the ABS connectors. Use the provided hammer to tap them firmly into place.
 - Check that the unit is placed on a flat, level surface.
- **Doors do not close properly:**
 - Verify that the door panels are correctly attached to their hinges/connectors.
 - Ensure no items inside the cube are obstructing the door's closure.
- **Missing or damaged parts:**
 - Review the "Package Contents" section. If parts are genuinely missing or damaged upon arrival, contact HOMIDEC customer support for replacements.
