SETUP

1. Choosing the Correct Size

Ensure your helmet is the correct size for a snug and comfortable fit. Refer to the Airroh size guide for detailed measurements. A properly sized helmet should not move freely on your head when shaken.

2. Fitting the Helmet

1. Grasp the chin straps and pull the helmet onto your head.
2. Ensure the helmet sits level on your head, with the top edge of the eye port just above your eyebrows.
3. Fasten the chin strap securely. It should be tight enough that you cannot pull the helmet off your head when pulling upwards from the rear.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Visor Operation

The visor can be opened and closed using the tab located at the bottom center. It features multiple detent positions for varying levels of airflow and visibility.

Ventilation System

The Airoh Valor helmet is equipped with 8 ventilation points to optimize airflow. Locate the adjustable vents on the chin bar and forehead. Slide the levers to open or close the vents as needed for comfort and fog prevention.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Exterior

Use a soft cloth dampened with mild soap and water to clean the helmet's exterior. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents, as they can damage the polycarbonate shell and graphics.

Cleaning the Visor

Remove the visor before cleaning. Use a clean, soft cloth and lukewarm water. For stubborn dirt, a specialized helmet visor cleaner can be used. Do not use harsh chemicals or paper towels, which can scratch the visor.

Cleaning the Interior Lining

The interior lining is removable for cleaning. Hand wash with mild soap and water, then air dry completely before reinserting. Ensure no moisture remains inside the helmet.

Storage

Store your helmet in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Use a helmet bag to protect it from dust and scratches.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Visor fogging:** Ensure vents are open. Consider using an anti-fog insert or spray.
- **Helmet feels loose:** Re-check sizing. Ensure chin strap is securely fastened. If still loose, the helmet may be too large.
- **Unusual noises:** Check for loose components or improperly seated visor.
