### 1. Introduction

- Children and Pets: Keep children and pets away from the cart during operation and assembly. This is not a toy.
- Assembly: Follow all assembly instructions carefully. Ensure all bolts and fasteners are securely tightened

before use.

- Maintenance: Regularly inspect the cart for any signs of wear, damage, or loose parts. Do not use if damaged.
- **Tire Pressure:** Maintain proper tire pressure as specified in the maintenance section to ensure optimal performance and safety.

# 3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The TecTake Garden Cart requires assembly. The package includes the garden cart components, assembly instructions, and mounting hardware. Follow the provided assembly instructions carefully for quick and straightforward setup.

### 3.1 Unpacking

- 5. Ensure all connections are firm and secure before first use.




Figure 2: Key features and components of the TecTake Garden Cart, illustrating its robust construction and design elements.

### 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The TecTake Garden Cart is designed for easy and comfortable operation.

# 4.1 Loading the Cart

- Place materials into the plastic body. Ensure the load does not exceed the maximum capacity of 120 kg.
- Distribute the weight as evenly as possible to maintain balance and ease of pulling.
- Avoid loading sharp objects that could puncture or damage the plastic body.

### 4.2 Transporting Materials

- Grasp the padded, non-slip handle firmly.
- The smooth-rolling steering axle allows for easy maneuvering. Guide the cart by pulling or pushing the handle.

• The pneumatic tires with tread and car valve ensure smooth and stable movement across various surfaces, including grass, soil, snow, asphalt, and gravel.

# 4.3 Tipping Function

The cart features a convenient tipping function for easy unloading.

- 1. Once at your desired unloading location, ensure the cart is on stable, level ground.
- 2. Locate the tipping mechanism (usually a latch or lever near the front of the cart body).
- 3. Release the latch and lift the front of the plastic body, allowing the contents to slide out.
- 4. Once emptied, lower the body back into place and secure the latch.




Figure 4: Illustration of the cart's tipping mechanism, showing how the bed can be tilted for easy unloading.

### 5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will extend the life of your TecTake Garden Cart.

### 5.1 Cleaning

- The robust plastic body is easy to clean. After each use, especially when transporting dirt or wet materials, rinse the body with water.
- For stubborn dirt, use a mild soap solution and a brush, then rinse thoroughly.
- Dry the metal parts to prevent rust, especially if stored outdoors.

#### **5.2 Tire Care**

- Check tire pressure periodically. The tires use a standard car valve, allowing for easy inflation with a bicycle pump or air compressor. Maintain recommended pressure for optimal performance and longevity.
- Inspect tires for any punctures, cracks, or excessive wear. Replace damaged tires as needed.

#### 5.3 General Inspection

- Regularly check all bolts, nuts, and fasteners for tightness. Tighten any loose connections.
- Inspect the steel frame for any signs of rust or structural damage. Address rust promptly with appropriate rust treatment or paint.
- Ensure the tipping mechanism operates smoothly and latches securely. Lubricate moving parts if necessary.
- Store the cart in a dry, sheltered area when not in use to protect it from the elements.

### 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your garden cart.

Cart feels unstable or wobbly.	<ul><li>Loose assembly bolts.</li><li>Damaged frame or axle.</li><li>Uneven tire pressure.</li></ul>	<ul> <li>Check and tighten all assembly bolts.</li> <li>Inspect frame and axles for damage; discontinue use if severely damaged.</li> <li>Ensure all tires are inflated to the same recommended pressure.</li> </ul>


