SETUP

Inserting SIM and microSD Cards

Before powering on your device, you will need to insert your SIM card(s) and an optional microSD card for expanded storage. The HTC U20 5G supports dual SIM functionality.

- 1. Locate the SIM card tray on the side of your phone.
- 2. Insert the SIM ejector tool into the small hole on the tray and push gently until the tray pops out.
- 3. Place your Nano SIM card(s) into the designated slots on the tray with the gold contacts facing down. If using a microSD card, place it in its dedicated slot.

4. Carefully push the tray back into the phone until it clicks into place.

Note: Ensure the phone is powered off before inserting or removing SIM or microSD cards to prevent data corruption.

Initial Power On and Setup

To power on your HTC U20 5G for the first time:

- 1. Press and hold the Power button (located on the right side of the phone) until the HTC logo appears.
- 2. The phone will boot up and display a welcome screen.







Figure 2: The initial welcome screen of the HTC U20 5G, prompting for language selection.

3. Follow the on-screen prompts to select your language, connect to a Wi-Fi network, set up your Google account, and configure security features like fingerprint unlock.






Figure 3: The language selection interface during the initial setup process.




Figure 4: Rear design of the HTC U20 5G, highlighting the camera module and fingerprint sensor.
