INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your Carlsbro ROCK50 3-Piece Junior Electronic Drum Kit. Please read these instructions thoroughly before assembly and operation to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your instrument. This electronic drum kit is designed for junior drummers and beginners aged 5 years and upwards, offering a compact and versatile drumming experience.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure all connections are secure before powering on the device.
- Use only the provided power adapter or a compatible USB-C power source.
- Keep the drum kit away from water, excessive heat, and direct sunlight.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on the drum pads or module.
- For prolonged listening, use headphones at moderate volume levels to prevent hearing damage.

- 1 x 7" Tom pad
- 1 x 8" Cymbal pad
- 1 x Bass kick pedal

- 1 x Junior drum throne (ROCK50BP1)
- 1 x Carlsbro DCN2 headphones (ROCK50BP1)

SETUP

1. Assembly of the Drum Rack

Assemble the height-adjustable tripod drum rack according to the included diagrams. Ensure all clamps and screws are tightened securely to provide a stable playing surface.

2. Attaching Pads and Cymbals

Mount the snare pad, tom pad, and cymbal pad onto the drum rack. Adjust their positions and angles for comfortable playing. The pads are designed for responsive feedback.

3. Connecting the Sound Module

Connect the pre-wired cables from each pad and cymbal to the corresponding inputs on the ROCK50 Sound Module. The module is powered via USB-C. Connect the bass kick pedal to its designated input on the module.

4. Powering On and Initial Adjustments

Connect the USB-C power cable to the module and a power source. Turn on the module. Adjust the volume using the dedicated control. For private practice, connect the included headphones to the headphone output jack.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Sound Module Functions:

- **108 High-Quality Percussion Voices:** Explore a wide range of drum and percussion sounds.
- **10 Preset Drum Kits:** Select from various pre-configured drum kits suitable for different music genres.
- **2 User Drum Kits:** Customize and save your own drum kit configurations.
- **10 Demo Songs:** Play along with built-in demo tracks to practice timing and rhythm.
- **Recording and Playback:** Record your drumming sessions and play them back for review and improvement.
- **Adjustable Metronome:** Use the metronome to develop precise timing. Adjust tempo as needed.

- **Aux Input:** Connect an external audio device (e.g., smartphone, MP3 player) to play along with your favorite songs.
- **Line Output:** Connect the module to an external amplifier or PA system for louder sound projection.
- **Headphone Output:** For private practice, connect headphones to this jack.
- **MIDI OUT:** Connect to MIDI-compatible devices or software for advanced music production.

Playing the Kit:

Strike the pads and cymbals with the drumsticks. The pads are velocity-sensitive, meaning the sound will vary in volume and tone depending on how hard you strike them. Use the bass kick pedal for the bass drum sound.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Clean the drum pads and module with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Regularly check all connections and tighten any loose screws on the drum rack.
- Store the drum kit in a cool, dry place when not in use.
- Avoid striking the pads or cymbals with excessive force to prevent damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Sound:** Ensure the module is powered on, headphones/speakers are connected correctly, and volume is turned up. Check all cable connections from pads to module.
- **Inconsistent Sound:** Verify that all cables are fully inserted into their respective ports. Ensure pads are securely mounted and not loose.
- **Pads Not Responding:** Check cable connections. If using batteries, ensure they are fresh or fully charged.
