Hoover H-Trifilter U98 Instruction Manual

For H-Purifier 500 and H-Purifier 700 Air Purifiers

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Hoover H-Trifilter U98 is an original replacement filter designed for Hoover H-Purifier 500 and H-Purifier 700 air purifiers. This filter features a triple-layer protection system to ensure optimal air purification performance.

- **Active Carbon Layer:** Effectively removes harmful gases and odors from the air, contributing to a fresher indoor environment.
- **Triple-Layer Filtration:** Guarantees the elimination of up to 99.97% of particles as small as 0.3 micrometers, including pollen, dust, and allergens.
- **Cylindrical Design:** The unique cylindrical shape of the H-Trifilter allows for a more efficient airflow compared to traditional flat filters, enhancing the purifier's overall performance.
- **Compatibility:** Specifically designed for use with Hoover H-Purifier 500 and H-Purifier 700 models.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand the following safety precautions before handling or installing the filter:

- Always unplug the air purifier from the power outlet before attempting to replace the filter.
- Do not wash or attempt to clean the H-Trifilter. It is designed for single-use and should be replaced when exhausted.
- Keep new and used filters out of reach of children and pets.
- Dispose of used filters according to local regulations for household waste.
- Handle the filter by its frame to avoid touching the filter media directly.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Your Hoover H-Trifilter U98 package should contain:

- 1 x Hoover H-Trifilter U98 replacement filter

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to replace the H-Trifilter in your Hoover H-Purifier 500 or 700:

1. **Power Off and Unplug:** Ensure your Hoover H-Purifier is turned off and completely unplugged from the electrical outlet before proceeding.
2. **Access Filter Compartment:** Refer to your H-Purifier's main instruction manual to locate and open the filter compartment. This usually involves removing a cover or panel.
3. **Remove Old Filter:** Carefully remove the used H-Trifilter from the purifier. It may be dusty, so handle it over a waste bin.
4. **Unpack New Filter:** Remove the new Hoover H-Trifilter U98 from its protective packaging.
5. **Insert New Filter:** Place the new filter into the compartment, ensuring it is seated correctly and securely. The cylindrical shape is designed for a specific fit.
6. **Close Compartment:** Close the filter compartment cover or panel, ensuring it is properly latched or secured according to your purifier's design.
7. **Restore Power:** Plug the air purifier back into the electrical outlet and turn it on.
8. **Reset Filter Indicator:** If your H-Purifier has a filter replacement indicator, follow the instructions in your purifier's main manual to reset it. This typically involves pressing and holding a specific button for a few seconds.




Image 4.1: The cylindrical Hoover H-Trifilter U98, ready for installation.

5. OPERATING THE FILTER (WITH H-PURIFIER)

The H-Trifilter U98 operates passively within your Hoover H-Purifier 500 or 700. Once installed, the air purifier draws air through the filter, where the triple-layer system captures particles, absorbs odors, and neutralizes harmful gases. No direct operation of the filter itself is required; its function is integrated into the air purifier's operation.

6. MAINTENANCE

The Hoover H-Trifilter U98 is a consumable component and requires regular replacement to maintain optimal air purification performance.

- **Replacement Frequency:** The filter typically needs to be replaced every 6 to 12 months, depending on usage and air quality conditions. Your Hoover H-Purifier will usually indicate when a filter change is due via a light or display message.
- **Disposal:** Dispose of the used filter as regular household waste. Do not attempt to clean or reuse it.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues after replacing your H-Trifilter, consider the following:

- **Purifier Not Turning On:** Ensure the air purifier is correctly plugged into a working power outlet and that the filter compartment is securely closed. Some purifiers have a safety switch that prevents operation if the compartment is open.
- **Filter Indicator Light Remains On:** After replacing the filter, you must manually reset the filter indicator on your Hoover H-Purifier. Refer to your purifier's main instruction manual for specific steps on how to perform this reset.
- **Reduced Air Quality:** If air quality does not seem to improve after filter replacement, ensure the new filter is correctly installed and that it is an authentic Hoover H-Trifilter U98. If the issue persists, consult your H-Purifier's main manual or contact Hoover customer support.
