- Always ensure the air fryer basket is properly inserted before operation.

SETUP

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the air fryer and all accessories from the packaging. Remove any stickers or labels.
- 2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wash the cooking pan and crisping tray in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. Wipe the exterior of the air fryer with a damp cloth.
- 3. **Placement:** Place the air fryer on a stable, heat-resistant, and level surface. Ensure there is adequate space (at least 6 inches) around the appliance for proper air circulation. Do not place it directly against a wall or under cabinets.

- 8. **Serve:** Carefully remove the cooking pan from the air fryer. Use heat-resistant tongs or utensils to remove food.



MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your Crux Digital Air Fryer.

- 1. Unplug and Cool: Always unplug the air fryer and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- 2. **Dishwasher Safe Parts:** The PFOA-free non-stick cooking pan and crisping tray are removable and dishwasher safe for convenient cleaning.
- 3. **Hand Washing:** For hand washing, use warm, soapy water and a non-abrasive sponge. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
- 4. **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the air fryer with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh abrasive cleaners or scouring pads, as they may damage the finish.
- 5. **Interior Cleaning:** Gently wipe the interior of the appliance with a damp cloth. Ensure no water enters the electrical components.
- 6. Storage: Store the air fryer in a cool, dry place once it is clean and completely dry.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Crux Digital Air Fryer, please refer to the following common solutions. If the problem persists, contact customer support.

• Appliance Not Turning On:

- $\circ~$ Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet.
- Check if the cooking pan is fully inserted into the air fryer unit. The appliance will not operate if the pan is not correctly seated.
- Verify that the power outlet is functional by plugging in another appliance.

• Food Not Cooking Evenly:

- Do not overfill the air fryer basket. Cook in smaller batches if necessary.
- Shake or flip food items halfway through the cooking process to ensure even browning.
- Ensure the temperature and time settings are appropriate for the food being cooked.

• White Smoke Emitting from Appliance:

- This can occur if there is excess oil or grease from food dripping into the bottom of the pan. Clean the pan thoroughly after each use.
- Ensure the crisping tray is clean and free of food residue.
