1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Greadio Retro Bluetooth Speaker and FM Radio. This device combines vintage design with modern audio technology, offering versatile playback options including Bluetooth, FM radio, TF card, and AUX input. This manual provides essential information for safe and optimal use of your speaker.

3. DEVICE LAYOUT

Familiarize yourself with the buttons and ports on your speaker.

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Speaker

The speaker is equipped with a built-in 1100mAh rechargeable battery. Before first use, fully charge the speaker.

1. Connect the provided charging cable (not explicitly listed as included, but implied for rechargeable battery) to the speaker's charging port.
2. Connect the other end of the charging cable to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port.
3. The charging indicator light will illuminate. It will turn off or change color once charging is complete.

A full charge typically provides up to 9 hours of playback time, depending on volume and usage.

4.2 Powering On/Off

- To power on: Rotate the volume knob clockwise or press and hold the power button (refer to device

layout for exact control).

- To power off: Rotate the volume knob counter-clockwise until it clicks, or press and hold the power button.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Bluetooth Mode

The speaker uses Bluetooth 4.2 for wireless connection.

1. Power on the speaker. It will automatically enter Bluetooth pairing mode, indicated by a flashing LED light.
2. On your mobile device (smartphone, tablet, etc.), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
3. Select "Greadio Speaker" (or similar name) from the list of devices.
4. Once connected, the LED indicator will stop flashing and remain solid. You can now play audio from your device through the speaker.

5.2 FM Radio Mode

Enjoy FM radio broadcasts with the built-in tuner.

1. Power on the speaker.
2. Switch the mode selector to "FM" (or press the Mode button until FM is selected).
3. Use the tuning dial to scan for radio stations. Rotate the dial slowly to find clear signals.
4. Adjust the volume using the volume knob.

Tip: For better FM reception, extend the antenna if available, or reposition the speaker.

5.3 TF Card Playback

Play MP3 audio files directly from a TF (MicroSD) card.

1. Insert a TF card (up to 32GB, formatted to FAT32) with MP3 files into the TF card slot.
2. Power on the speaker. The speaker should automatically switch to TF card mode or you may need to select it using the Mode button.
3. Playback will begin automatically. Use the control buttons (e.g., Play/Pause, Next/Previous) to manage playback.

5.4 AUX Input Mode

Connect external audio devices using the provided AUX cord.

1. Connect one end of the AUX cord to the speaker's AUX input port.
2. Connect the other end of the AUX cord to the headphone jack or audio output of your external device (e.g., MP3 player, computer).
3. Switch the speaker's mode selector to "AUX" (or press the Mode button until AUX is selected).
4. Play audio from your external device. Adjust volume on both the speaker and the external device.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the speaker's surface. Do not use abrasive cleaners, alcohol, or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the speaker in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the speaker regularly, even if not in use for extended periods.
- **Water Exposure:** This speaker is not waterproof. Avoid exposure to water or high humidity.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Speaker does not power on.	Battery is depleted.	Charge the speaker fully.
No sound.	Volume is too low; incorrect mode selected; device not connected properly.	Increase volume; ensure correct mode (Bluetooth, FM, TF, AUX) is selected; re-pair Bluetooth or re-connect AUX cable.
Bluetooth connection fails.	Speaker is too far from device; speaker not in pairing mode; interference.	Ensure speaker is within 10 meters of device; restart speaker and device; try pairing again.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Poor FM radio reception.	Weak signal; environmental interference.	Reposition the speaker; extend the antenna if applicable.
