### 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The LuckyTail Pet Nail Grinder is designed to provide a gentle, quiet, and effective solution for pet nail care. Its patented design minimizes noise and vibration, making the grooming process less stressful for both pets and owners. Equipped with LED lights for precision and a durable diamond bit grinder, it is suitable for various pet sizes.

## **3. SETUP**

### **3.1 Initial Charging**

Before first use, fully charge the LuckyTail Pet Nail Grinder. Connect the provided USB charging cable to the grinder's charging port and a compatible USB power source. The device charges in approximately one hour and provides over four hours of operating time.

### 3.2 Familiarizing Your Pet with the Grinder

To ensure a positive experience, introduce the grinder to your pet gradually. Allow them to sniff and investigate the device while it is off. Once they are comfortable, turn the grinder on (without touching their nails) so they can get used to the low sound and vibration. Reward calm behavior with treats and praise.

Avoid making sudden movements or scaring your pet during this process. Patience is key to building a positive association with nail grooming.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

## 4.1 Selecting Grinding Speed and Port

The LuckyTail Pet Nail Grinder features two speed modes and multiple grinding ports to accommodate different nail sizes and grinding needs:

- **Speed 1 (Whisper Quiet):** Ideal for small dogs, short nails, or for initial familiarization. Operates at 8,000 RPM.
- **Speed 2 (Low Vibration):** Suitable for larger dogs or longer nails, providing more power. Operates at 10,000 RPM.

The grinder head features multiple openings. Choose the appropriate port for your pet's nail size. The larger port is suitable for bigger nails, while the smaller port is for finer grinding or smaller pets. You can also remove the protective cover for full 360-degree grinding if needed.

## 4.2 Grinding Process

1. **Positioning:** Hold your pet's paw firmly but gently. Ensure their fur is clear of the grinding head. The two built-in LED lights will illuminate the nail, helping you identify the quick (the sensitive part of the nail).
2. **Grinding:** Insert the nail into the chosen grinding port. Apply light pressure and grind the nail in short bursts of 3-5 seconds to prevent overheating and discomfort.
3. **Check Progress:** After each short burst, check the nail's length and shape. Continue until the desired length is achieved, being careful not to grind too close to the quick.
4. **Reward:** Consistently reward your pet with treats and praise throughout the grinding session to reinforce positive behavior.

For optimal results, grind nails every 2-4 weeks, or as needed, to maintain healthy nail length.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

### 5.1 Cleaning the Grinder Head

After each use, it is important to clean the grinder head to remove nail dust and debris. This ensures optimal performance and hygiene.

1. Remove the protective cover from the grinding head.
2. Use the provided cleaning cloth or a small brush to gently wipe away any accumulated nail dust from the grinding wheel and the surrounding area.
3. Replace the protective cover.

## 5.2 Replacing Grinder Heads

The diamond bit grinder heads are durable but will wear down over time. It is recommended to replace the grinder head every 2-3 months, or sooner if you notice a decrease in grinding efficiency.

- **Regular Grinder Head:** Perfect for small to medium-sized paws.
- **Hard Grinder Head:** Coarser grit for larger breeds or very thick nails.
- **Soft Grinder Head:** Finer grit for buffing and smoothing nails to avoid harsh edges.

## 5.3 Storage

Store the LuckyTail Pet Nail Grinder in its original storage box in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and out of reach of pets and children.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

### 6.1 Grinder Not Turning On or Charging

- Ensure the device is fully charged. Connect it to a USB power source and check if the charging indicator light is on.
- Verify the USB cable is not damaged and is securely connected to both the grinder and the power source.
- Try a different USB port or power adapter.

### 6.2 Grinding Ineffective or Slow

- Check if the grinder head is clogged with nail dust. Clean it thoroughly as described in the Maintenance section.
- The grinder head may be worn out. Replace it with a new one.
- Ensure you are using the appropriate speed setting for your pet's nail thickness.
- Apply gentle, consistent pressure. Excessive pressure can slow down the motor.

### 6.3 Pet Shows Discomfort or Fear

- Revisit the familiarization steps outlined in the Setup section.
- Ensure you are not grinding too close to the quick. The LED lights are designed to help with this.
- Use the lowest speed setting initially and gradually increase as your pet becomes more comfortable.
- Shorten grinding sessions and increase frequency, focusing on positive reinforcement.
