1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Safariland Model 7378 Automatic Locking System (ALS) Holster is designed for the H&K VP9 firearm, offering a secure and rapid-draw solution for right-handed users. Constructed from durable plastic, this holster features the innovative ALS retention system, which automatically secures the firearm once holstered, providing an enhanced level of security against unauthorized removal.

2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

This holster is typically supplied with a paddle attachment for convenient on/off wear. Ensure the holster is securely attached to your belt or waistband before use.

2.1 Attaching the Holster

1. Position the paddle attachment inside your waistband, ensuring the holster body is on the outside.
2. Slide the paddle over your belt, ensuring it is fully seated and stable. The paddle's design provides a secure grip on your clothing and belt.
3. Verify the holster is firmly in place and does not shift excessively during movement.

2.2 Retention Adjustment

The ALS system provides automatic retention. However, some models may feature an adjustable tension screw to fine-tune the draw resistance. If present, locate the tension screw (usually near the trigger guard area) and adjust clockwise for tighter retention or counter-clockwise for looser retention. Test the draw and re-holster action after each adjustment to ensure optimal performance and security.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Holstering the Firearm

1. With the holster securely attached, orient the firearm to align with the holster's opening.
2. Insert the firearm smoothly into the holster.
3. Push the firearm down until you hear and feel a positive click. This indicates that the Automatic Locking System (ALS) has engaged and secured the firearm.
4. Gently tug on the firearm to confirm it is securely retained by the ALS.

3.2 Drawing the Firearm

1. Establish a firm grip on the firearm's grip.
2. Using your thumb, depress the ALS lever, which is typically located on the inside of the holster, near the body.
3. While depressing the lever, draw the firearm straight up and out of the holster. Avoid twisting or canting the firearm during the draw.
4. Practice drawing and re-holstering in a safe environment with an unloaded firearm until proficient.

4. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and reliable operation of your Safariland holster.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the holster regularly with a damp cloth to remove dirt, dust, and debris. For stubborn grime, a mild soap solution can be used, followed by a clean, damp cloth. Ensure the holster is completely dry before re-holstering a firearm.
- **Avoid Harsh Chemicals:** Do not use strong solvents, abrasive cleaners, or petroleum-based products, as these can damage the plastic material and finish.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the holster for any signs of wear, cracks, or damage, especially around the retention mechanism and attachment points. If any damage is found, discontinue use and consider replacement.

- **Lubrication:** The ALS mechanism generally does not require lubrication. If the mechanism feels stiff, ensure it is clean and free of debris.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Safariland 7378 ALS Holster, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Difficulty drawing firearm	ALS lever not fully depressed; excessive tension; debris in mechanism.	Ensure full depression of ALS lever; adjust tension screw (if applicable) counter-clockwise; clean mechanism.
Firearm not locking into place	Firearm not fully seated; debris obstructing mechanism.	Push firearm firmly until click is heard; inspect and clean inside of holster and ALS mechanism.
Holster feels loose on belt	Paddle not fully engaged; incorrect belt size.	Ensure paddle is fully seated over belt; use a belt that fits snugly with the paddle attachment.


