# One For All Panasonic URC4914 TV Replacement Remote Control User Manual

Model: URC4914

#### 1. Introduction

This manual provides instructions for the One For All URC4914 Panasonic TV Replacement Remote Control. This remote is designed to function as a direct replacement for your original Panasonic TV remote, offering compatibility with various Panasonic TV types including LCD, LED, and Plasma models. It supports common Panasonic functions and includes a learning feature for customization.

# 2. SETUP

# 2.1. Battery Installation

The URC4914 remote control requires two AA batteries (not included). Follow these steps to install them:

- 1. Locate the battery compartment cover on the back of the remote control.
- 2. Slide the cover downwards or press the latch (if present) to open the compartment.
- 3. Insert two AA batteries, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the markings inside the compartment.
- 4. Replace the battery compartment cover by sliding it back into place until it clicks securely.

# 2.2. Initial Use

No setup is required for basic functionality. Once batteries are installed, the remote is ready to operate all compatible Panasonic televisions. Point the remote towards your TV and press the **POWER** button to test.

# 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The URC4914 remote control features a standard layout for Panasonic TVs. Below is an overview of key buttons and their functions.

# 3.1. Button Functions

- POWER: Turns the TV on or off.
- INPUT/TV/AV: Selects the input source (e.g., HDMI 1, AV, TV tuner).
- VIERA LINK: Activates Panasonic's Viera Link function for connected devices.
- **GUIDE:** Displays the electronic program guide (EPG).
- APPS/NETFLIX/HOME: Provides quick access to smart TV applications, specifically Netflix, and the TV's home menu.

- Navigation Pad (Up, Down, Left, Right, OK): Used for menu navigation and selection.
- EXIT/MENU/BACK: Exits menus, opens the main menu, or goes back to the previous screen.
- VOL +/-: Adjusts the volume level.
- PR +/- (Channel +/-): Changes TV channels.
- MUTE: Mutes or unmutes the TV audio.
- Playback Controls (Play, Pause, Stop, Rewind, Fast Forward, Record): Controls media playback on compatible devices or TV functions.
- Number Pad (0-9): Direct channel selection and data entry.
- INFO: Displays information about the current program or input.

### 3.2. Learning Feature

The URC4914 remote includes a learning function, allowing you to copy functions directly from your original remote control. This is useful for any specific functions not pre-programmed or for customizing button assignments.

- 1. Place the URC4914 remote and your original remote on a flat surface, facing each other, approximately 1-2 inches apart.
- 2. Press and hold the **SETUP** button (if present, or a combination like **SHIFT + SETUP**) on the URC4914 until the LED blinks twice and then stays lit.
- 3. Press the button on the URC4914 remote that you wish to program. The LED will blink rapidly.
- 4. Press and hold the corresponding button on your original remote. The URC4914's LED should blink twice to confirm successful learning.
- 5. Repeat for other buttons you wish to learn.
- 6. To exit learning mode, press the **SETUP** button again.

Note: Specific steps for entering learning mode may vary. Refer to the full One For All manual for detailed instructions if the above does not apply.

# 4. MAINTENANCE

#### 4.1. Battery Replacement

When the remote's performance degrades or it stops responding, it is likely time to replace the batteries. Always replace both AA batteries at the same time with new ones. Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries.

# 4.2. Cleaning

To clean the remote control, use a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or wet cloths, as these can damage the remote's surface or internal components.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

#### · Remote not responding:

- Check if the batteries are inserted correctly with the correct polarity.
- Replace the batteries with fresh AA batteries.
- Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the TV's infrared sensor.
- $\circ~$  Make sure you are within the effective range of the TV's IR receiver.

#### · Specific buttons not working:

• If you used the learning feature, try re-learning the function for that specific button.

• Ensure your TV model supports the function you are trying to use.

### • Remote works intermittently:

- This often indicates low battery power. Replace the batteries.
- Ensure the remote's infrared emitter is clean and free from dust.
