INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Badabulle B-Easy 4-in-1 Baby Food Processor. This appliance is designed to simplify the preparation of healthy and delicious meals for your baby. It combines steaming and blending functions in one compact unit, allowing you to cook and mix ingredients simultaneously. Please read this manual carefully before first use to ensure proper operation, maintenance, and safety.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and personal injury.

- Read all instructions before use.
- Do not immerse the electrical base unit in water or other liquids.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use, before assembling or disassembling parts, and before cleaning.
- Avoid contact with moving parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessories not recommended or sold by the manufacturer may cause fire, electric shock, or injury.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.

- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.
- Exercise caution when handling the sharp blending blade.
- Ensure the lid is securely locked in place before operating the blending function.
- Allow hot food to cool slightly before blending to prevent pressure buildup.

PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the parts of your Badabulle B-Easy food processor:

- **Main Base Unit:** Contains the motor and heating element.
- **Steaming Basket:** For holding food during steaming.
- **Steaming Jug:** Transparent jug for steaming, with handle.
- **Steaming Lid:** Covers the steaming jug.
- **Water Reservoir:** Located in the base unit for steaming water.
- **Blending Jug:** Transparent jug for blending, with handle and blade assembly.
- **Blending Lid:** Covers the blending jug.
- **Control Buttons:** One button for steaming, one for blending.

SETUP AND FIRST USE

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wash all parts that come into contact with food (steaming basket, steaming jug, blending jug, lids, blade assembly) in warm soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry. The electrical base unit should only be wiped with a damp cloth.
3. **Assembly:**
 - Place the main base unit on a stable, flat surface.
 - Ensure the water reservoir is empty and clean.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Overall Operation Flow

Steaming Food

- 1. Prepare Ingredients:** Wash, peel, and chop fruits, vegetables, or meat into small, uniform pieces (approximately 1-2 cm).
- 2. Add Water:** Fill the water reservoir in the base unit with clean water. Refer to the markings on the base for recommended water levels based on cooking time or food type.

3. **Load Food:** Place the chopped ingredients into the steaming basket. Do not overfill. Insert the steaming basket into the steaming jug, then place the steaming jug onto the left side of the base unit.
4. **Secure Lid:** Place the steaming lid securely on top of the steaming jug.
5. **Start Steaming:** Plug in the appliance. Press the steaming button (usually indicated by a steam icon or located on the left side). The indicator light will illuminate, and steaming will begin.

6. **Completion:** The appliance will automatically shut off when the water reservoir is empty, indicating the steaming cycle is complete.
7. **Careful Removal:** Use oven mitts or a cloth to carefully remove the hot steaming jug and basket. Be aware of hot steam.

Blending Food

1. **Transfer Food:** Once steamed, transfer the cooked ingredients from the steaming basket into the blending jug. You can also add some of the collected cooking juice to achieve the desired consistency and retain nutrients.
2. **Secure Blending Jug:** Place the blending jug onto the right side of the base unit.
3. **Secure Lid:** Place the blending lid securely on top of the blending jug. Ensure it is properly locked to prevent spills.
4. **Start Blending:** Press and hold the blending button (usually indicated by a blade icon or located on the right side). Blend in short pulses until the desired consistency is reached. Do not continuously blend for more than 30 seconds at a time to prevent overheating.

5. **Check Consistency:** Release the button to stop blending. Check the food consistency and blend further if needed.

Simultaneous Steaming and Blending

The Badabulle B-Easy allows for simultaneous steaming and blending, optimizing meal preparation time.

1. Follow steps 1-4 for Steaming Food.
2. While food is steaming, prepare ingredients for blending (if different) or wait for the steaming cycle to complete.
3. Once steaming is complete, transfer the steamed food to the blending jug.
4. Follow steps 2-4 for Blending Food.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures hygiene and extends the life of your appliance.

1. **Unplug:** Always unplug the appliance from the power outlet before cleaning.
2. **Disassemble:** Disassemble all removable parts: steaming basket, steaming jug, blending jug, lids, and blade assembly.
3. **Dishwasher Safe Parts:** All removable components (steaming basket, jugs, lids, blade assembly) are dishwasher safe. Place them on the top rack for best results.
4. **Hand Washing:** For hand washing, use warm soapy water and a soft brush for the blade assembly. Rinse thoroughly.
5. **Base Unit:** Wipe the main base unit with a damp cloth. Do not immerse it in water or any other liquid.
6. **Descaling:** Over time, mineral deposits may build up in the water reservoir. To descale, mix equal parts water and white vinegar. Pour into the reservoir and run a steaming cycle without food. Rinse thoroughly afterwards by running two cycles with clean water.
7. **Storage:** Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling and storing the appliance in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet not working.	Ensure the appliance is securely plugged into a functional power outlet.
Steaming function not working.	No water in the reservoir; reservoir lid not properly closed.	Fill the water reservoir to the appropriate level. Ensure the steaming lid is securely in place.
Blending function not working.	Blending jug or lid not correctly assembled; food pieces too large.	Ensure the blending jug is correctly seated and the lid is securely locked. Cut food into smaller pieces. Do not overfill.
Food not blending smoothly.	Insufficient liquid; food pieces too large or too hard.	Add more cooking juice or a small amount of water/milk. Ensure food is adequately steamed and cut into small pieces. Blend in shorter pulses.
Steam escaping excessively during steaming.	Steaming lid not properly sealed.	Ensure the steaming lid is correctly positioned and securely closed.
