INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your OneTouch Verio Reflect Blood Glucose Monitoring System. This kit is designed to help individuals monitor their blood glucose levels for diabetes management. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference.

WHAT'S INCLUDED

Your OneTouch Verio Reflect Blood Glucose Monitoring System includes the following components:

- 1 OneTouch Verio Reflect Blood Glucose Meter
- 30 OneTouch Verio Test Strips
- 30 OneTouch Delica Plus Lancets
- 1 OneTouch Delica Plus Lancing Device

SETUP GUIDE

Inserting Test Strips

- 1. Remove a OneTouch Verio Test Strip from its vial. Close the vial cap immediately to protect the remaining strips.
- 2. Insert the test strip into the test strip port of the OneTouch Verio Reflect Meter. The meter will automatically turn on.
- 3. Wait for the meter to display the "Apply Blood" symbol, indicating it is ready for a blood sample.

Preparing the Lancing Device

- 1. Unscrew the cap from the OneTouch Delica Plus Lancing Device.
- 2. Insert a new sterile OneTouch Delica Plus Lancet firmly into the lancet holder.
- 3. Twist off the protective cap from the lancet and save it for safe disposal.
- 4. Replace the lancing device cap.
- 5. Adjust the depth setting on the lancing device by rotating the dial. Start with a lower setting and increase if needed to get a sufficient blood sample.
- 6. Pull back the cocking control until it clicks, indicating the device is ready to use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Performing a Blood Glucose Test

- 1. Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and warm water. Dry them completely.
- 2. Hold the lancing device firmly against the side of your fingertip. Press the release button to prick your finger.
- 3. Gently squeeze your finger to obtain a small drop of blood.
- 4. Touch the tip of the test strip to the blood drop. The blood will be drawn into the strip automatically. Do not apply blood to the top of the test strip.
- 5. The meter will display your blood glucose result in 5 seconds.
- 6. After testing, carefully remove the used test strip and dispose of it properly. Unscrew the lancing device cap, remove the used lancet, and dispose of it in a puncture-resistant container.

Understanding Your Results

The OneTouch Verio Reflect Meter uses ColorSure® Plus technology and Blood Sugar Mentor™ messages to provide personalized guidance.

- ColorSure® Plus Technology: Each time you test, the ColorSure® Dynamic Range Indicator points out if your reading is low (blue), within range (green), or high (red). This visual cue helps you understand your results at a glance.
- **Blood Sugar Mentor™ Messages:** The meter provides personalized messages based on your blood glucose readings, offering guidance and encouragement to help you manage highs and lows.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Clean the meter and lancing device regularly with a soft, damp cloth. Do not immerse the devices in water or use harsh cleaning agents.
- Storage: Store the meter, test strips, and lancets in a cool, dry place between 41°F and 86°F (5°C and 30°C). Keep them away from direct sunlight and heat.
- Battery Replacement: The meter uses 2 Lithium Metal batteries (included). Replace them when the low battery indicator appears on the display.

If you encounter issues with your OneTouch Verio Reflect system, refer to the table below for common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Meter displays Error 4 or Error 5	Test strip issue (e.g., insufficient blood, damaged strip, expired strip)	Ensure adequate blood sample. Use a new, unexpired test strip. Refer to the Owner's Booklet for specific error codes.
Meter turns off unexpectedly	Low battery or meter malfunction	Replace batteries. If the issue persists, contact customer support.
Difficulty obtaining blood sample with lancing device	Incorrect depth setting or improper technique	Increase the depth setting on the lancing device. Ensure proper technique as described in the Operating Instructions.
