SAFETY INFORMATION

- Ensure the dehumidifier is placed on a stable, level surface.
- Do not block air inlets or outlets. Maintain at least 20 cm clearance around the unit.
- Do not operate the unit with a damaged power cord or plug.
- Always unplug the unit before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- Do not immerse the unit, power cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- The unit features an automatic shut-off function when the water tank is full. Do not override this safety feature.

SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your dehumidifier for the first time.

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the dehumidifier from its packaging. Retain packaging materials for future storage or transport.
2. **Placement:** Place the unit upright on a firm, level surface in the desired location. Ensure there is at least 20 cm of space around all sides for proper airflow.
3. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.
4. **Water Tank:** Ensure the water tank is correctly inserted into the unit.
5. **Continuous Drainage (Optional):** For continuous operation without emptying the water tank, connect the provided drain hose to the drainage port and direct the other end to a suitable drain.

Control Panel Functions:

- **Power Button:** Press to turn the unit ON or OFF.
- **Humidity Setting:** Adjust the desired humidity level (30%-80%). The unit will operate until the set humidity is reached.
- **Fan Speed:** Select between low and high fan speeds.
- **Timer:** Set a timer for automatic shut-off (up to 24 hours).
- **Sleep Mode:** Reduces fan speed and dims display lights for quiet operation during sleep.
- **Child Lock:** Locks the control panel to prevent accidental changes.
- **Dehumidify Mode:** Select specific dehumidification modes if available (e.g., continuous, auto).

Humidity Indicator Light:

The dehumidifier features a three-color indicator light to show the current humidity level:

- **Blue:** Humidity < 50%
- **Green:** Humidity 50%-70%
- **Red:** Humidity > 70%

MAINTENANCE

Emptying the Water Tank:

When the water tank is full, the unit will automatically shut off and an indicator light will illuminate. Carefully remove the tank and empty the collected water.

Cleaning the Air Filter:

The air filter should be cleaned regularly (e.g., every two weeks or as needed) to maintain efficiency. A dirty filter can reduce performance and increase energy consumption.

- 1. Turn off and unplug the dehumidifier.
- 2. Locate and remove the air filter (typically on the back or side of the unit).
- 3. Clean the filter with a vacuum cleaner or wash it with warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly.
- 4. Allow the filter to air dry completely before reinserting it into the unit.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Dehumidifier does not turn on.	No power; Water tank full or incorrectly inserted.	Check power connection; Empty and reinsert water tank correctly.
No water collected or low dehumidification.	Humidity level already low; Air filter clogged; Room too large; Temperature too low.	Adjust humidity setting; Clean air filter; Ensure unit is suitable for room size; Dehumidifiers are less effective in cold temperatures.
Unit is noisy.	Unit not on a level surface; Air filter clogged; Normal compressor noise.	Place on a level surface; Clean air filter; Some operating noise is normal.
Error code displayed.	Specific internal issue.	Refer to the specific error code in the full manual or contact customer support.
