

1. Introduction

3. Setup

- Playback Controls: Use the Rewind, Play/Pause, and Fast Forward buttons for media playback.
- Instant Replay: The Instant Replay button (curved arrow) allows you to jump back a few seconds in video playback.
- Star Button: The Star button (*) provides quick access to options within certain apps or menus.
- Shortcut Buttons: Dedicated buttons for Netflix, Hulu, and Vudu allow direct access to these streaming services.

6. Troubleshooting

• Remote Not Responding:

- Ensure batteries are inserted correctly with the proper polarity.
- · Replace old batteries with new AAA batteries.
- Check for any obstructions between the remote and the TV's infrared receiver.
- Ensure you are within a reasonable range and have a clear line of sight to the TV.

• Specific Buttons Not Working:

- Clean the remote control buttons and surrounding areas to remove any debris that might be causing sticking.
- If only specific buttons are unresponsive after checking batteries, the remote may be faulty and require replacement.

· Limited Range:

- The remote operates using infrared (IR) technology. Ensure there are no strong light sources (like direct sunlight) interfering with the IR signal.
- Move closer to the TV and ensure a direct line of sight.
