1. Product Overview

The TECKNET Trucker Bluetooth Headset (Model TK-HS001) is designed for clear and comfortable communication in various environments, including offices, homes, call centers, and for truck drivers. It features advanced AI noise-canceling technology for the microphone, ensuring your voice is heard clearly by others, even in noisy surroundings. The headset offers all-day comfort with soft ear cushions and a rotatable microphone for flexible use.

3. Setup

3.1 Charging the Headset

Before first use, fully charge the headset. Connect the provided Type-C charging cable to the headset's charging port and the other end to a USB power source. A full charge takes approximately 1.5 hours. It is not recommended to use the headset while charging.

3.2 Connecting via USB Dongle (Recommended for PC)

1. Insert the USB dongle into an available USB port on your computer or device.
2. Power on the TECKNET headset. It will automatically attempt to connect to the dongle.
3. Once connected, the headset will indicate a successful pairing (e.g., a steady blue light on the dongle). This method provides a stable connection with minimal transmission delay.

3.3 Connecting via Bluetooth (for Mobile Phones & Other Bluetooth Devices)

1. Ensure the headset is powered on and in pairing mode (refer to the headset's indicator lights for pairing status, usually a blinking blue light).
2. On your mobile phone or Bluetooth-enabled device, go to Bluetooth settings and search for available devices.
3. Select "TECKNET TK-HS001" (or similar name) from the list of devices.

4. Once paired, the headset will indicate a successful connection (e.g., a solid blue light).

4. Operating Instructions

4.1 Headset Controls

The headset features intuitive controls for managing calls and audio:

- **MFB Button:** Used to answer or hang up calls (primarily for phone calls).
- **Volume + / - Buttons:** Adjust the audio volume.

- **Mute Button with LED Indicator:** Single click to mute or unmute the microphone during a mobile phone call. Note: The mute function is active only during a call on mobile phones and cannot be used when not on a call.

4.2 Microphone Usage

The microphone is designed for optimal voice pickup and flexibility:

- **270° Rotatable Microphone:** The microphone can be rotated 270 degrees, allowing it to be positioned on either the right or left side of your head for comfort and preference.
- **AI Noise Cancelling:** The integrated AI noise-canceling microphone can eliminate up to 99.6% of background noise, ensuring crystal-clear communication for the listener.

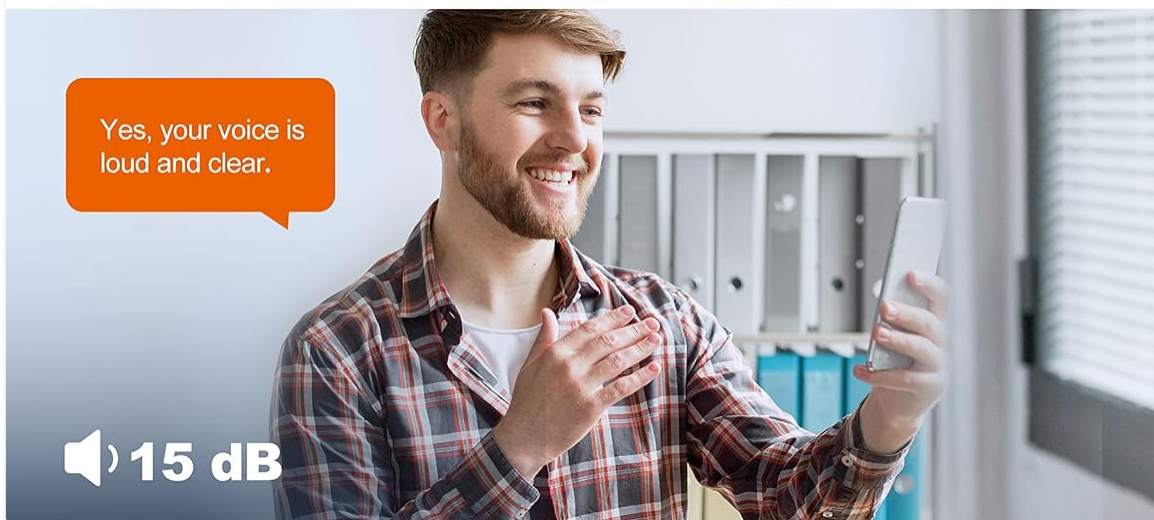


Image: A visual representation of the headset's AI noise-canceling microphone effectively reducing background noise from 90dB to 15dB during a call.

5. Maintenance

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your TECKNET headset, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Gently wipe the headset, especially the ear cushions and microphone, with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** Store the headset in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

- **Battery Care:** For optimal battery life, avoid fully discharging the headset frequently. Charge it regularly, but do not leave it plugged in for extended periods after it's fully charged. The headset provides up to 50 hours of work time and 85 hours of standby time on a single charge.
- **Handling:** Handle the microphone boom gently when rotating it to prevent damage.

6. Troubleshooting

If you encounter any issues with your TECKNET headset, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Solution
Headset not connecting via Bluetooth/Dongle	Ensure the headset is powered on and fully charged. Verify the USB dongle is securely inserted into a working USB port. For Bluetooth, ensure your device's Bluetooth is enabled and the headset is in pairing mode. Try restarting both the headset and the connecting device.
Microphone not picking up sound	Check if the microphone is muted (LED indicator on the mute button). Ensure the microphone is positioned correctly near your mouth. Verify audio input settings on your computer or phone (e.g., in Skype, Zoom, or system sound settings).
Mute button not working outside of calls	This is normal behavior. The mute key is designed to function only during active mobile phone calls.
Audio quality issues (e.g., static, low volume)	Adjust the volume on both the headset and your connected device. Ensure you are within the 10-meter Bluetooth range of your device. Check for interference from other wireless devices.
