## SAFETY INFORMATION

### WARNING: CHOKING HAZARD - Small parts. Not for children under 3 years.

- Always supervise children during play.
- Ensure all parts are securely assembled before use.
- Do not use real food or liquids in the appliances unless specified.
- Keep batteries out of reach of small children.

## SETUP

*Note: The product specifications indicate 2 AAA batteries are included for certain functions. Additional batteries may be required for other electronic components.*

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 1. Kitchen Mixer

The mixer can be used as a stand mixer or a portable hand mixer. The beaters are designed to rotate for realistic play. To operate, ensure batteries are installed (if applicable) and activate the power switch. The mixer body can be easily removed from its stand for handheld use.

## 2. Coffee Maker

The coffee maker features a detachable coffee pot. Fill the top compartment with play water (not included) and press the power button (if battery-operated) to simulate brewing with realistic lights and sounds.

## 3. Toaster

Insert the two play bread slices into the toaster slots. Push down the lever (if applicable) and turn the dial to simulate toasting. The bread slices will pop up when the 'toasting' cycle is complete.

## 4. Blender

The blender has a removable lid. Place play items (not included) inside the blender cup. Press the power button (if battery-operated) to activate the spinning action and light effects, simulating a real blender.

## MAINTENANCE

- Clean all plastic parts with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not immerse electronic components in water.
- Ensure all parts are dry before storing.
- Remove batteries from electronic appliances if the toy will not be used for an extended period.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

## Appliance Not Functioning (Electronic Parts)

- Check if batteries are correctly installed with the proper polarity.
- Replace old or depleted batteries with new ones.
- Ensure the power switch is in the 'ON' position.
