INTRODUCTION

The Yaheetech 36-inch Outdoor Wood Burning Fire Pit is designed for outdoor gatherings, offering a rustic aesthetic with its oil-rubbed bronze finish and diamond cutouts. It features a deep circular bowl for ample wood capacity and 360-degree fire view, supported by sturdy steel construction. An outer ring provides a convenient handle for portability and acts as a safety barrier. This fire pit includes a mesh spark screen, poker, and rain cover for comprehensive use and protection.

Key Features

- **Eye-catching Rustic Outdoor Addition:** The oil-rubbed bronze finish lends a distinctive rustic feel to this wood-burning firepit. Moreover, the diamond cutouts on the fire bowl exude a mysterious allure when the flame dances within the frame, bringing ambiance to your bonfire nights.
- **Large Fire Bowl With Mesh Diamond Pattern:** The 10.5 inch / 26 cm deep circular bowl of this round fire pit for outdoors has an aesthetic and functional diamond pattern around the wall, providing cozy warmth and ambiance, and a 360-degree view of the fire and allowing better airflow.
- **Solid Steel Construction & Good Heat Resistance:** Founded atop three sturdy metal legs, this 36 inch round garden fire pit features a heavy-duty metal construction finished with high-temperature paint, ensuring high strength and durability to withstand the heat of flames.
- **Outer Ring Adds More Convenience & Safety:** The ring around this round fire pit serves as a handle, making it easy to move around the yards/patios/porches. The outer ring also prevents users from accidentally touching the scalding fire bowl.
- **Convenient Portability:** Elevated on three sturdy legs, this 36 inch outdoor fire pit can be easily moved around in your yards/patios/porches with the outer ring. This makes it the perfect companion for any outdoor adventure, providing you with the cozy glow of a captivating bonfire on chilly nights.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Always supervise children around the fire pit. Place on a stable, non-flammable surface at least 10 feet away from flammable materials. Use the included mesh screen to prevent sparks from escaping and causing fires.

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to assemble your Yaheetech Fire Pit:

1. **Assemble the Spark Screen:** Attach the handle to the center of the mesh spark screen using the provided hardware.
2. **Attach the Legs:** Securely fasten the three sturdy legs to the underside of the main fire bowl. Ensure all screws are tightened for stability.
3. **Install the Outer Ring:** Position the outer ring around the top edge of the fire bowl and attach it using the designated connection points and hardware. This ring serves as a handle and an additional safety barrier.
4. **Place the Fire Grate:** Insert the metal fire grate into the bottom of the fire bowl. This elevates the wood for better airflow and combustion.
5. **Position the Spark Screen:** Once the fire pit is ready for use, place the assembled mesh spark screen on top of the fire bowl to contain sparks and embers.
6. **Apply Rain Cover (when not in use):** For protection against the elements, cover the entire fire pit with the provided rain cover when it is cool and not in use.

CIRCULATING AIR

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To ensure safe and enjoyable use of your fire pit, follow these operating guidelines:

- **Fuel Type:** Use only seasoned firewood. Avoid using lighter fluid, gasoline, or other flammable liquids to start or rekindle a fire.
- **Starting a Fire:** Place a small amount of kindling (e.g., newspaper, small twigs) on the fire grate, followed by larger pieces of seasoned firewood. Light the kindling, allowing the flames to spread to the wood.
- **Airflow:** The fire pit's design includes vents for optimal airflow. Ensure these are not blocked to maintain a consistent burn.
- **Spark Screen:** Always use the mesh spark screen when the fire is lit to prevent embers and sparks from escaping. Use the included poker to safely lift and replace the screen when adding wood or tending the fire.
- **Safety Distance:** Maintain a safe distance from the fire pit, especially when the fire is burning. The outer ring provides a cooler surface for handling the unit when cool, but the main bowl and inner components will be extremely hot.
- **Extinguishing the Fire:** Allow the fire to burn down naturally. Do not use water to extinguish the fire, as this can damage the fire pit's finish and create steam hazards. Once the fire is completely out and ashes are cool, proceed with maintenance.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your fire pit:

- **Ash Removal:** Once the fire pit and ashes are completely cool, remove all ashes and debris from the bowl. Regular cleaning prevents corrosion and maintains proper airflow.
- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the exterior surfaces with a damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that could damage the finish.
- **Storage:** When not in use, especially during inclement weather or off-season, cover the fire pit with the provided rain cover to protect it from moisture and prolong its lifespan. Store in a dry area if possible.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your fire pit, consider the following:

- **Difficulty Starting Fire:** Ensure you are using dry, seasoned firewood. Wet or green wood will be difficult to ignite and produce excessive smoke. Check that the airflow vents at the bottom are clear of ash or debris.
- **Excessive Smoke:** This is often caused by unseasoned or damp wood. Use only dry, seasoned hardwood. Avoid overloading the fire pit, as this can also restrict airflow and lead to more smoke.
- **Rust Formation:** While the fire pit is designed with high-temperature paint, prolonged exposure to moisture can lead to rust. Ensure the fire pit is covered with the provided rain cover when not in use and stored in a dry location. Minor surface rust can often be cleaned and touched up with high-temperature paint.
- **Unstable Legs:** Periodically check the leg attachments to ensure all screws remain tight. Re-tighten if any wobbling is detected.




