1. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do not expose the radio to water or excessive moisture.
- · Avoid extreme temperatures.
- Do not disassemble the unit. Refer servicing to qualified personnel.
- Use only specified AAA batteries. Ensure correct polarity during installation.
- Prolonged listening at high volume levels can cause hearing damage. Adjust volume to a comfortable level.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Retekess TR624 is a compact AM/FM radio designed for portability. Its transparent casing allows visibility of internal components. It operates on AAA batteries and includes a pair of crystal-clear headphones.

2.1. Components and Controls

- Frequency Selection Dial: Used to tune into radio stations.
- Band Selection Switch (FM/AM): Toggles between FM and AM radio bands.
- Volume Knob: Adjusts the audio output level.
- Power On/Off Switch: Turns the radio on or off.
- **Headphone Jack (3.5mm):** For connecting the included headphones.
- **Detachable Back Clip:** For attaching the radio to clothing or a belt.
- Battery Compartment: Houses two AAA batteries.

3. SETUP

3.1. Battery Installation

- 1. Locate the battery compartment cover on the back of the radio.
- 2. Slide the cover open.
- 3. Insert two (2) AAA batteries, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals match the indicators inside the compartment.

4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

3.2. Headphone Connection

The Retekess TR624 radio does not have an internal speaker and requires headphones for audio output. The included headphones also serve as the FM antenna.

- 1. Insert the 3.5mm plug of the headphones into the headphone jack located on the side of the radio.
- 2. For optimal FM reception, extend the headphone cable as much as possible.

4. OPERATION

4.1. Power On/Off

Slide the **Power On/Off** switch to the 'ON' position to turn on the radio. Slide it to 'OFF' to power down the unit.

4.2. Band Selection (AM/FM)

Use the **Band Selection Switch** to choose between the AM (Amplitude Modulation) and FM (Frequency Modulation) radio bands.

4.3. Tuning

Rotate the **Frequency Selection Dial** to scan for available radio stations. The dial displays the frequency range for both AM and FM bands.




Figure 4.1: Tuning dial for AM and FM frequencies. The tuning dial displays both AM (520-1710 KHz) and FM (87-108 MHz) frequency ranges. Rotate the tuning wheel to find your desired station.

4.4. Volume Adjustment

Turn the **Volume Knob** up or down to adjust the listening volume through the headphones.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1. Cleaning

Wipe the radio's exterior with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.

5.2. Storage

When not in use for extended periods, remove the batteries to prevent leakage. Store the radio in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

5.3. Battery Replacement

Replace batteries when audio becomes distorted or the radio fails to power on. Follow the battery installation steps in Section 3.1.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound	Radio is off; low batteries; headphones not connected; volume too low.	Turn on radio; replace batteries; connect headphones; increase volume.
Poor reception	Weak signal; headphone cable not extended (FM); interference.	Relocate radio; fully extend headphone cable (FM); avoid electronic devices causing interference.
Tuning difficulty	Fine-tuning required.	Slowly adjust the tuning dial for precise station lock.
