## 2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The BLACK+DECKER BPP10WTB is a versatile 3-in-1 portable air conditioner designed to provide cooling, dehumidification, and fan-only operation for your living space.



## 3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Proper setup is crucial for optimal performance and safety. Please follow these steps carefully. For a comprehensive guide, refer to the official [Installation Manual \(PDF\)](#).

### Installation Steps:

- 1. Unpacking:** Carefully remove the unit and all accessories from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
- 2. Choosing a Location:** Place the unit on a firm, level surface near a window and a grounded electrical outlet. Ensure there is at least 20 inches of space around the unit for proper airflow.
- 3. Window Kit Installation:** Assemble the window slider kit according to the instructions in the installation manual. Insert the exhaust hose into the window kit and connect it to the unit's exhaust outlet. Ensure a tight seal to prevent air leakage.
- 4. Drain Hose Connection:** For continuous dehumidification, connect the drain hose to the unit's drain port and direct it to a

suitable drainage area.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your BLACK+DECKER portable air conditioner can be operated using the control panel on the unit or the included full-function remote control.



# Full Function Remote Control

4 cooling +3 fan speeds*

## Remote Control Functions:

- **Power On/Off:** Press the power button (U) to turn the unit on or off.
- **Mode Selection:** Cycle through Cooling, Dehumidifier, and Fan-only modes using the Mode button.
- **Temperature Adjustment:** Use the Up (^) and Down (v) arrows to set your desired temperature.
- **Fan Speed:** Select Low, Medium, or High fan speed to control airflow.
- **Timer Function:** Set a timer for the unit to automatically turn on or off after a specified period.
- **Sleep Mode:** Activates a quiet operation mode that gradually adjusts the temperature for comfortable sleep.
- **Fan Swing:** Engage the fan swing function to oscillate the air vents, distributing air more widely.
- **Celsius/Fahrenheit Toggle:** Switch between Celsius and Fahrenheit temperature displays.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and efficient operation of your portable air conditioner. Always unplug the unit before performing any maintenance.

## Maintenance Procedures:

- **Air Filter Cleaning:** The air filter should be cleaned every two weeks or more frequently depending on usage and air quality.

1. Gently slide out the filter from its housing.
  2. Wash the filter with warm, soapy water.
  3. Rinse thoroughly and allow it to air dry completely before reinserting.
- **Water Drainage:** The unit has an auto-evaporation system, but in high humidity conditions, the internal water tank may fill. When the tank is full, the unit will stop operating and display an error code. Drain the water by removing the drain plug and allowing water to flow into a suitable container.
  - **Seasonal Storage:** Before storing the unit for an extended period, ensure the water tank is completely drained. Clean the air filter and allow the unit to run in fan-only mode for a few hours to dry the internal components. Store the unit upright in a cool, dry place, preferably in its original packaging.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your portable air conditioner, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps. For more detailed solutions, consult the full user manual PDF.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on	No power, tripped circuit breaker, full water tank.	Check power connection, reset breaker, drain water tank.
Unit not cooling effectively	Dirty air filter, blocked exhaust hose, room too large, open windows/doors.	Clean filter, ensure hose is clear and properly installed, close windows/doors, check room size.
Unit is noisy	Unit not level, foreign object in fan, normal operation sounds.	Ensure unit is on a level surface, check for obstructions, some noise is normal during operation.
Water leakage	Drain plug not secured, drain hose kinked or blocked.	Secure drain plug, clear any kinks or blockages in the drain hose.
