1. INTRODUCTION

3. SETUP

3.1 Unpacking

Carefully remove the projector and all accessories from the packaging. Verify that all components are present:

- AUN ET30C Mini Projector
- Power Adapter
- Remote Control
- HDMI Cable (may vary by package)
- User Manual

3.2 Placement

Place the projector on a stable, flat surface. Ensure adequate ventilation around the projector to prevent overheating. The optimal projection distance ranges from 3.08 feet to 9.32 feet, yielding a screen size of 30 to 100 inches.

3.3 Power Connection

Connect the power adapter to the projector's power input port, then plug the adapter into a power outlet. The projector requires a direct power connection for operation.

3.4 Connecting External Devices

The AUN ET30C features multiple ports for connecting various devices:

- **Audio Out:** Connect external speakers or headphones for enhanced audio.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Powering On/Off

Press the power button on the projector or the remote control to turn the unit on or off.

4.2 Focus Adjustment

Rotate the focus ring located near the lens to achieve a clear image. Adjust until the projected image is sharp.

4.3 Screen Mirroring (Wired/Wireless)

The ET30C supports screen mirroring for iOS and Android devices:

- **Wireless Connection:** Access the Wi-Fi mirroring function from the projector's menu. Follow the on-screen instructions to connect your smartphone or tablet to the projector's Wi-Fi network, then enable screen mirroring on your device.
- **Wired Connection:** Connect your iOS or Android device directly to the projector using a compatible USB/Lightning cable.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Lens

Use a soft, lint-free cloth specifically designed for optical lenses to gently wipe the projector lens. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or excessive force.

5.2 Dust Removal

Regularly clean the projector's vents to ensure proper airflow and prevent dust buildup. Use a soft brush or compressed air to remove dust from the ventilation openings.

5.3 Storage

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Power:** Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to both the projector and a working power outlet.
- **No Image:** Verify that the correct input source is selected. Check all cable connections (HDMI, AV, USB). Adjust the focus ring.
- **Blurred Image:** Rotate the focus ring to sharpen the image. Ensure the projection surface is flat and the projector is at an appropriate distance.
- **No Sound:** Check the volume settings on both the projector and the connected device. Ensure external speakers are properly connected if used.
- **Screen Mirroring Issues:** For wireless mirroring, ensure both devices are on the same Wi-Fi network and the mirroring function is enabled on your mobile device. For wired mirroring, ensure the cable is compatible and securely connected.
