1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Read all instructions carefully before using the fan. Failure to follow these instructions may result in electric shock, fire, or serious personal injury.

- Always unplug the fan from the power outlet before cleaning, servicing, or moving it.
- Do not operate the fan with a damaged cord or plug. If the cord or plug is damaged, contact qualified service personnel for repair or replacement.
- Keep children and pets away from the fan during operation.
- Do not insert fingers or any other objects through the grille when the fan is operating.
- Ensure the fan is placed on a stable, level surface to prevent tipping.
- Do not use this fan near water, such as in a bathroom, laundry area, or swimming pool.
- This fan is rated for indoor and outdoor use. When used outdoors, ensure the power outlet is suitable for outdoor use and protected from moisture.
- The fan is equipped with a GFCI plug for enhanced safety. Do not bypass or modify this safety feature.

2. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The iLiving 30-inch Commercial Pedestal Oscillating Fan requires some assembly. Follow these steps to ensure proper setup.

2.1 Unpacking

- Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
- Verify that all parts listed in the [Specifications](#) section are present.
- Retain packaging for future storage or transport.

2.2 Base Assembly

1. Place the heavy-duty pedestal base on a flat, stable surface.
2. Attach the main support pole to the base, securing it with the provided screws and washers.

2.3 Fan Head Attachment

1. Carefully lift the fan head assembly and align it with the top of the support pole.
2. Secure the fan head to the pole using the designated fasteners. Ensure it is firmly attached to prevent wobbling during operation.

2.4 Height Adjustment

The fan's height is adjustable from 55 to 72 inches. Loosen the height adjustment knob on the support pole, extend or retract the pole to the desired height, and then firmly tighten the knob to secure the fan in place.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section details how to operate your iLiving Commercial Pedestal Oscillating Fan.

3.1 Powering On/Off and Speed Control

- Plug the fan's GFCI power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
- The fan features a pull chain switch for power and speed control.
- Pull the chain once to turn the fan ON at the lowest speed (7400 CFM).
- Pull the chain again to cycle through the medium speed.
- Pull the chain a third time for the highest speed (8400 CFM).
- Pull the chain a fourth time to turn the fan OFF.

3.2 Oscillation Control

The fan head can be configured for oscillation or fixed positioning. The fan has a 70-degree oscillating sweep.

- To enable oscillation, locate the oscillation pin/lever on the motor housing and engage it.
- To stop oscillation and fix the fan in one direction, disengage the oscillation pin/lever.

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your fan.

4.1 Cleaning

- **Always unplug the fan before cleaning.**
- Use a soft, damp cloth to wipe down the exterior surfaces of the fan. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- To clean the fan blades, remove the front grille by unscrewing the retaining clips or screws. Carefully wipe the blades with a damp cloth.
- Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling the grille and plugging in the fan.

4.2 Storage

When not in use for extended periods, store the fan in a cool, dry place, preferably in its original packaging, to protect it

from dust and damage.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your iLiving fan, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan does not turn on.	No power, GFCI tripped, damaged cord/plug.	Check power outlet, reset GFCI, inspect cord/plug for damage.
Reduced airflow.	Dirty blades or grille.	Clean fan blades and grille as described in the Maintenance section.
Fan is noisy.	Loose parts, fan not on a level surface, debris in blades.	Ensure all parts are tightened, place fan on a level surface, check for and remove any debris.
Oscillation not working.	Oscillation pin/lever not engaged.	Engage the oscillation pin/lever on the motor housing.
