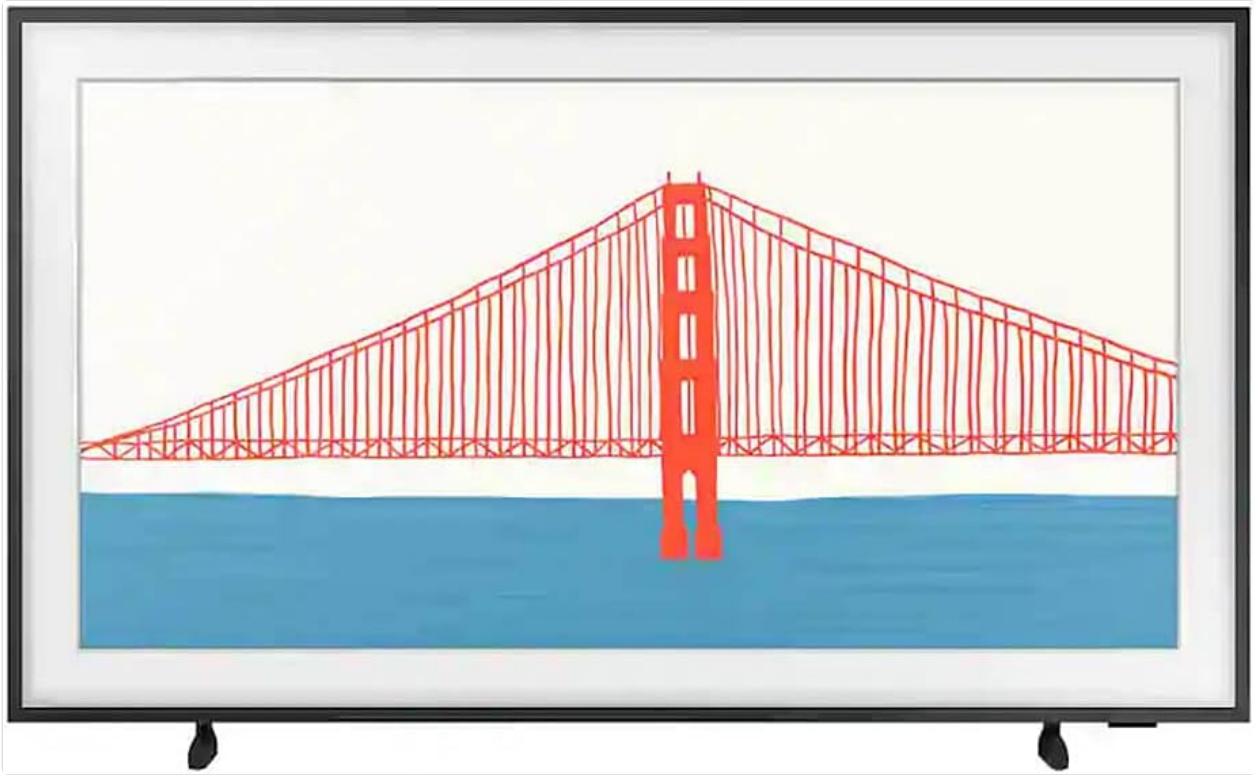
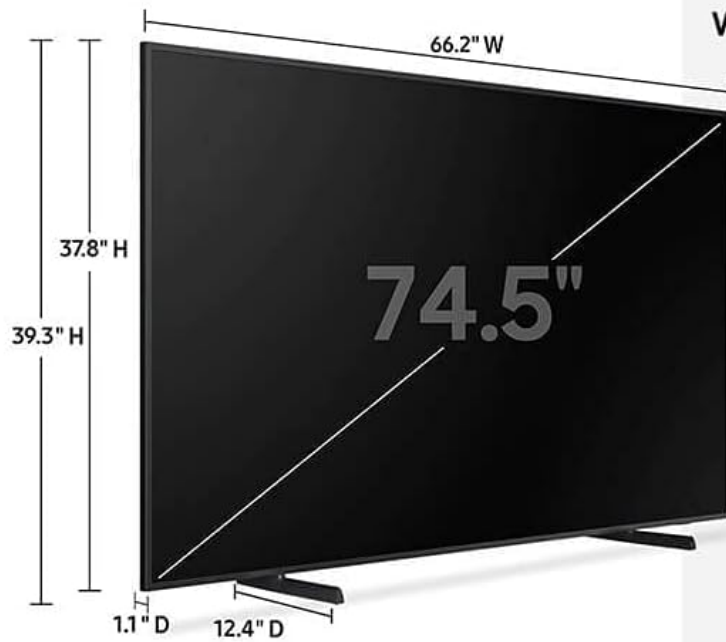

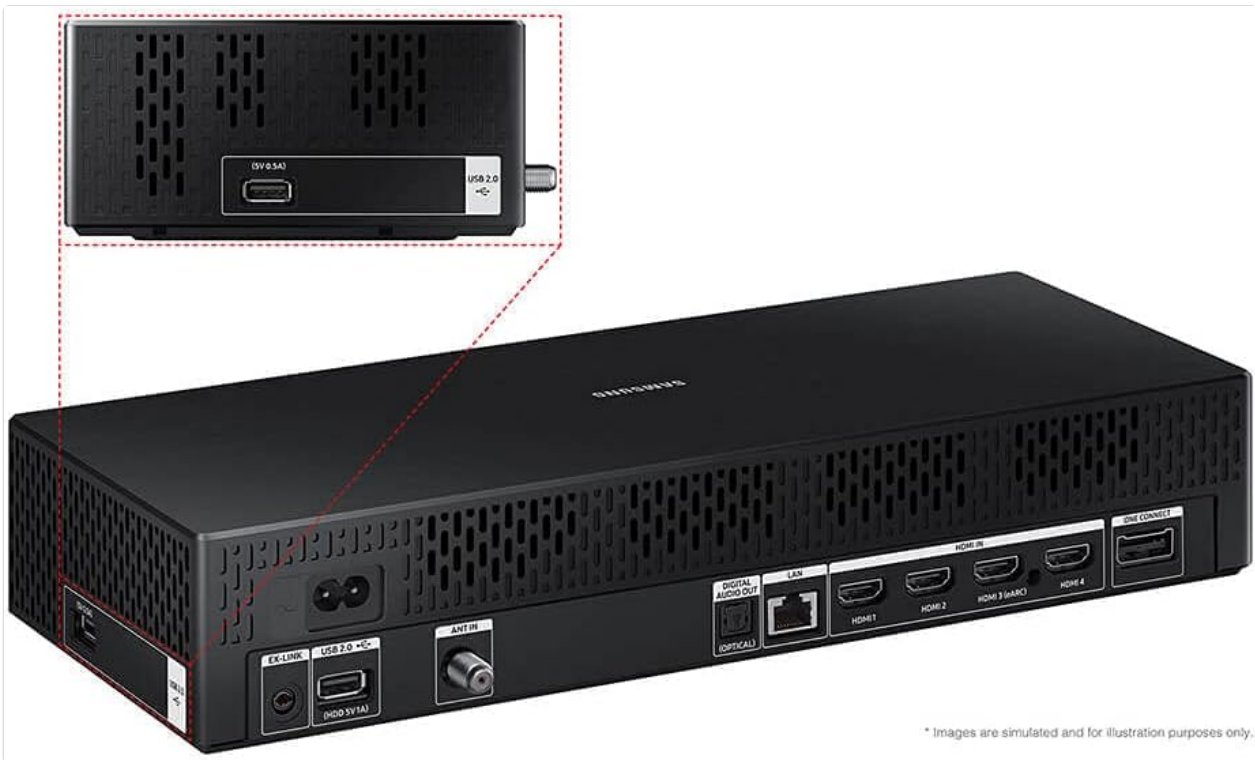
3. SETUP

3.1 Initial Placement

Choose a suitable location for your TV. Ensure the surface is stable if using the included stands, or the wall is structurally sound if using the wall mount. Maintain adequate ventilation around the TV.

3.2 Connecting the One Connect Box

The One Connect Box centralizes all your device connections, simplifying cable management. Connect all external devices (e.g., cable box, gaming console, Blu-ray player) to the One Connect Box using HDMI, USB, or other relevant ports. Then, connect the One Connect Box to the TV using the single, thin One Connect cable.

3.3 Power Connection

Connect the power cable to the One Connect Box, then plug it into a wall outlet. The TV will receive power through the One Connect cable.

3.4 Wall Mounting (Optional)

If using the Slim Fit Wall Mount, follow the detailed instructions provided with the mount for secure installation. This mount allows the TV to sit flush against the wall, enhancing its art-like appearance.

4. OPERATING YOUR TV

4.1 Basic Controls

Use the included SolarCell Remote (TM-2180E) to navigate the TV's interface. The remote is designed for intuitive control of channels, volume, and smart features.

4.2 Smart TV Features (Tizen OS)

Your Frame TV runs on Samsung's Tizen operating system, providing access to a wide range of apps and streaming services. Connect your TV to your home Wi-Fi network during the initial setup to access these features. Navigate through the Smart Hub to find your favorite content.

4.3 Art Mode

When the TV is turned off, it can transition into Art Mode, displaying a selection of digital art. Access the Art Store to browse and subscribe to a vast library of artworks. You can also upload your own photos to display.

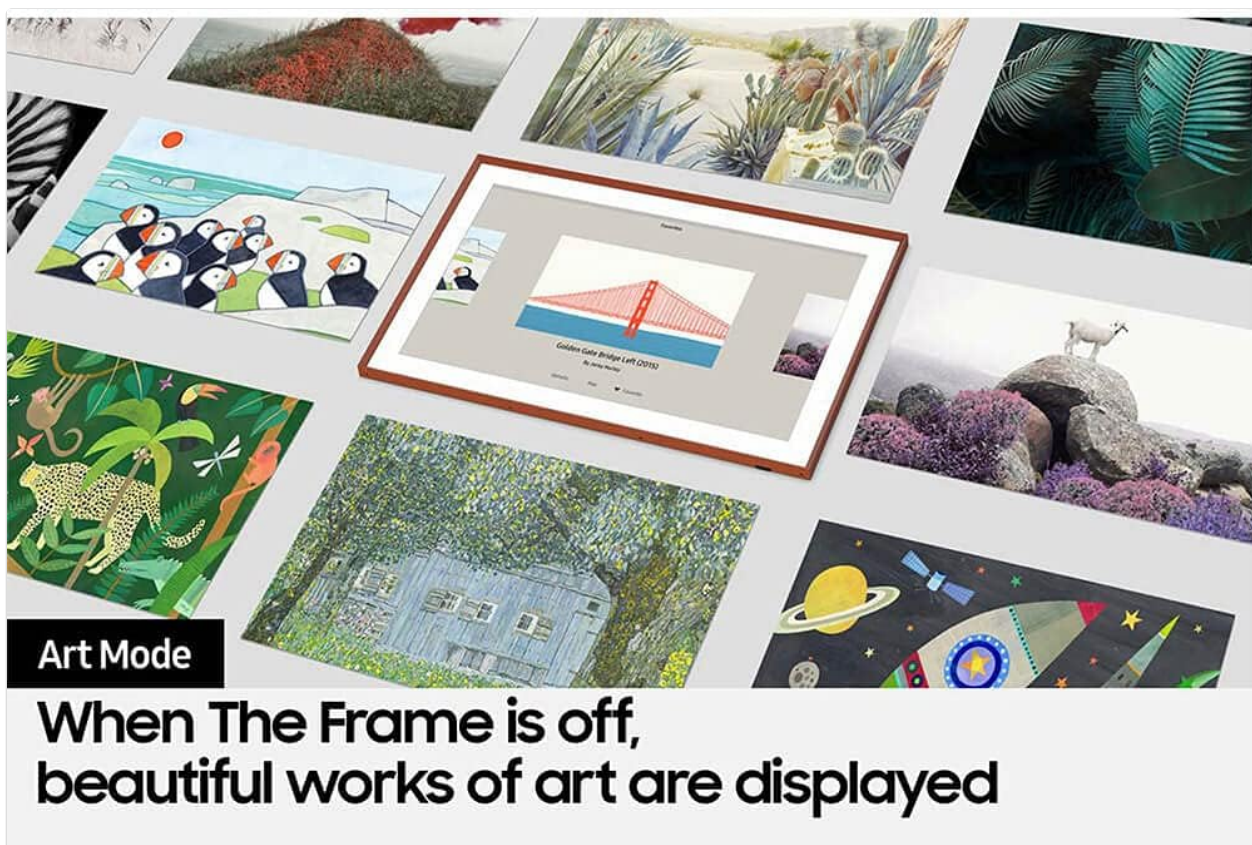

4.4 Voice Assistants

The TV has built-in support for Amazon Alexa, Google Assistant, and Bixby. Use voice commands to change channels, adjust volume, launch apps, search for content, and control compatible smart home devices.

4.5 QLED Technology

Experience vibrant and accurate colors with Quantum Dot technology, which delivers 100% Color Volume. The Quantum Processor 4K intelligently upscales content to 4K resolution, optimizing picture and sound quality.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Screen

Gently wipe the screen with a soft, dry microfiber cloth. For stubborn smudges, lightly dampen the cloth with distilled water. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or direct spraying of liquids onto the screen.

5.2 Cleaning the Frame and Body

Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the TV's frame and body. Do not use liquid cleaners directly on the TV.

5.3 Software Updates

Ensure your TV's software is up to date for optimal performance and security. The TV can be set to automatically download and install updates when connected to the internet.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your TV, try the following basic troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power:** Check if the power cable is securely connected to the One Connect Box and the wall outlet. Ensure the outlet is functional.
- **No Picture/Sound:** Verify that the One Connect cable is properly connected between the TV and the One Connect Box. Check input source settings.
- **Remote Not Working:** Ensure the SolarCell Remote is charged (expose to light for charging). If issues persist, try pairing the remote again according to the E-Manual.
- **Network Connection Issues:** Restart your router and modem. Reconnect the TV to your Wi-Fi network

through the settings menu.

- **Picture Quality Issues:** Adjust picture settings (brightness, contrast, sharpness) in the TV menu. Ensure the content source is high quality.
