1. INTRODUCTION

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The AXA Juno Steady is designed for pack carrier mounting. Follow these steps for proper installation:

1. **Positioning:** Identify a suitable mounting point on your bicycle's rear rack. The light should be positioned to provide maximum visibility to the rear.
2. **Mounting:** Secure the light to the pack carrier using the provided nuts. Ensure the light is firmly attached and does not wobble.
3. **Electrical Connection:** The Juno Steady can be connected to either a flank dynamo, a hub dynamo, or a 6V e-bike battery pack. Use the practical pressure connections on the light for wiring. Ensure correct polarity if applicable (refer to your dynamo or e-bike system's manual for specific wiring diagrams).

5. OPERATION

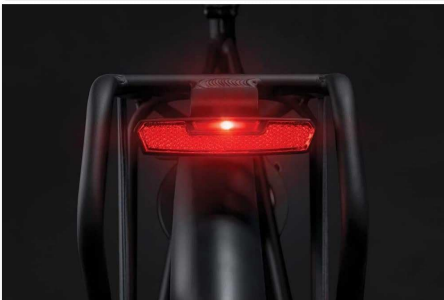
The AXA Juno Steady is a dynamo-powered light, meaning it generates its own electricity as you ride. It features a 'Steady Mode' function.

- **Automatic Activation:** The light will illuminate automatically when the bicycle is in motion and connected to a functioning dynamo.

- **Steady Mode:** Thanks to its integrated capacitor, the light will remain illuminated for a period even when the bicycle stops, such as at traffic lights. This ensures continuous visibility and safety.

6. MAINTENANCE

The AXA Juno Steady is built with durable construction and is water-resistant (IPX6 rated). Regular maintenance will ensure its longevity and optimal performance.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the light and reflector with a soft, damp cloth to remove dirt and grime. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Connection Check:** Periodically inspect the electrical connections to ensure they are secure and free from corrosion.
- **Mounting Check:** Ensure the light remains securely mounted to the bicycle rack. Tighten nuts if necessary.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your AXA Juno Steady light, consider the following:

- **Light Not Illuminating:**
 - Check all electrical connections from the dynamo to the light. Ensure they are secure and correctly wired.
 - Verify that your dynamo is functioning correctly.
 - Ensure the bicycle is moving at a sufficient speed for the dynamo to generate power.
- **Dim Light:**
 - Clean the light's lens and reflector.
 - Check for any loose or corroded electrical connections.
- **Light Flickers:**

- Inspect wiring for any damage or intermittent connections.
- Ensure the dynamo is providing a consistent power supply.




