## INTRODUCTION

The Graco Video Baby Monitor is designed to provide parents with a convenient and reliable way to monitor their baby. Featuring a 2.4-inch display, two-way audio, 2X zoom, and night vision, this wireless system ensures you can see and hear your baby clearly from various locations within your home. Its compact and rechargeable design makes it ideal for both home use and travel.

## PACKAGE CONTENTS

- Parent Unit (2.4" Display Monitor)
- Baby Unit (Camera)
- USB Charging Cable
- Power Adapter (may vary by region)

## PRODUCT FEATURES

## SETUP

### 1. Charging the Monitor

Before first use, fully charge the Parent Unit. Connect the USB charging cable to the Parent Unit and a compatible USB power adapter. The battery indicator on the screen will show charging status.

### 2. Positioning the Camera (Baby Unit)

Place the Baby Unit (camera) in a secure location in your baby's room, ensuring it has a clear, unobstructed view of the crib or play area. For optimal viewing, position the camera approximately 3-6 feet away from the baby. Ensure the camera is out of reach of children.

### 3. Powering On

Press and hold the Power button on both the Parent Unit and the Baby Unit until the indicator lights turn on. The units are pre-paired from the factory and should connect automatically.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 1. Power On/Off

Press and hold the **Power button** on the Parent Unit to turn it on or off.

## 2. Adjusting Volume

Use the **Volume Up** and **Volume Down** buttons on the Parent Unit to adjust the audio level.

## 3. Using Two-Way Audio

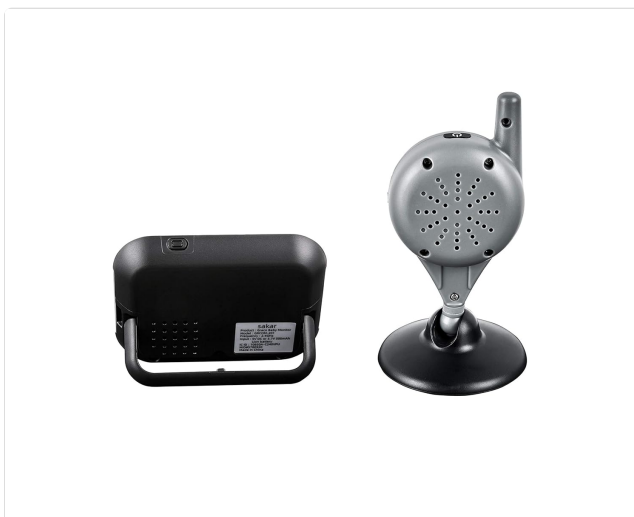
Press and hold the **Talk button** on the Parent Unit to speak to your baby through the camera's speaker. Release the button to listen.

## 4. Zoom Function

Press the **Zoom button** on the Parent Unit to activate the 2X digital zoom. Press again to return to normal view.

## 5. Night Vision

The camera automatically activates night vision in low-light conditions, providing a clear black and white image on the Parent Unit.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the monitor and camera with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the Parent Unit frequently. Charge it regularly. If storing for extended periods, charge it every few months.
- **Storage:** Store the units in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No picture/sound on Parent Unit	Out of range; Low battery; Units not powered on.	Move Parent Unit closer to Baby Unit; Charge Parent Unit; Ensure both units are powered on.
Picture is blurry or unclear	Lens is dirty; Insufficient lighting (for color view).	Clean camera lens with a soft cloth; Ensure adequate lighting or rely on night vision.
Audio cuts in and out	Interference; Out of range.	Move units away from other electronic devices; Move Parent Unit closer to Baby Unit.
Parent Unit battery drains quickly	Frequent use; Battery degradation over time.	Ensure full charge before use; Reduce screen brightness; Keep plugged in during extended use.
