INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides detailed guidance for assembling and operating the MEGA HFC18 Paw Patrol Rescue Vehicle Building Kit. This kit allows children to recreate exciting rescue scenes from the Paw Patrol movie, featuring 87 building blocks and 4 movable figures: Chase, Marshall, Liberty, and Skye. Follow these instructions carefully to ensure proper assembly and maximum enjoyment.

PARTS LIST

Before beginning assembly, please ensure all components are present. This kit contains 87 building blocks and special pieces, along with 4 character figures.

- 87 assorted building blocks and special pieces for vehicles and tower.
- 1 Chase figure.
- 1 Marshall figure.
- 1 Liberty figure.
- 1 Skye figure.


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to assemble your Paw Patrol Rescue Vehicle Building Kit.

1. Assemble the Humdinger Tower

1. Begin by connecting the base pieces to form the foundation of the tower.
2. Build the main structure of the tower using the grey and purple blocks, ensuring the archways are correctly positioned.
3. Attach the rotating platform to the top section of the tower.
4. Install the clear blue slide pieces at the base of the tower for Chase's motorcycle exit.

2. Assemble Chase's Motorcycle

1. Connect the blue motorcycle base pieces.
2. Attach the wheels securely to the motorcycle frame.
3. Place the Chase figure onto the assembled motorcycle.

3. Assemble Marshall's Fire Truck

1. Build the red and white body of the fire truck.
2. Attach the wheels and the clear blue windshield.
3. Assemble the white ladder mechanism and attach it to the top of the truck, ensuring it can tilt.
4. Place the Marshall figure into the driver's seat.

4. Assemble Liberty's Scooter

1. Connect the base and body pieces for Liberty's scooter.
2. Attach the wheels.
3. Secure the hook accessory to the scooter.
4. Place the Liberty figure onto the scooter.

5. Assemble Skye's Helicopter

1. Build the pink body of the helicopter.
2. Attach the rotor blades to the top.
3. Install the rescue winch with its hook mechanism.
4. Place the Skye figure into the helicopter.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once assembled, the Paw Patrol Rescue Vehicle Building Kit offers various interactive play features:

- **Chase's Tower Exit:** Position Chase's motorcycle at the top of the clear blue slide on the Humdinger tower. Release the motorcycle to watch Chase slide out for a quick rescue.
- **Skye's Helicopter Landing:** The rotating platform at the top of the tower is designed for Skye's helicopter to land and take off. Use the helicopter's winch to simulate aerial rescues.
- **Marshall's Tilting Ladder:** The ladder on Marshall's fire truck can be tilted up and down to reach different heights during imaginative rescue scenarios.
- **Liberty's Hook:** Use the hook on Liberty's scooter for various rescue tasks, such as towing or lifting small objects.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and cleanliness of your building kit, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe blocks and figures with a damp cloth and mild soap if necessary. Rinse thoroughly and air dry. Do not submerge electronic components (if any) in water.

- **Storage:** Store the building blocks and figures in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Keep small pieces in a container to prevent loss.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check for any damaged or worn-out pieces. Replace if necessary to maintain play safety and functionality.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues during assembly or play, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Solution
Pieces do not fit securely.	Ensure you are using the correct pieces as indicated in the instructions. Apply gentle, even pressure. If a piece consistently does not fit, check for any manufacturing defects or debris in the connection points.
Missing parts.	Carefully check the packaging and surrounding area. If parts are genuinely missing, contact customer support with your product model number and purchase details.
Figures do not stay on vehicles.	Ensure the figures are correctly seated on the designated studs or slots on the vehicles. Some movement is normal during play.
