3. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your iPhone XS or XS Max.

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean your device. Avoid abrasive materials or harsh chemicals.
- **Software Updates:** Regularly check for and install iOS updates to ensure security and access to new

features. Go to **Settings > General > Software Update**.

- **Battery Health:** Monitor your battery health in **Settings > Battery > Battery Health** and follow Apple's recommendations for charging practices.
- **Storage Management:** Periodically review and manage your device storage to free up space. Go to **Settings > General > iPhone Storage**.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

This section addresses common problems you might encounter with your iPhone XS or XS Max and provides basic troubleshooting steps.

- **Device Unresponsive:** If your iPhone is frozen, perform a force restart: Press and quickly release the Volume Up button, then press and quickly release the Volume Down button, then press and hold the Side button until you see the Apple logo.
- **Wi-Fi/Cellular Connectivity Issues:** Try toggling Wi-Fi or Cellular Data off and on. If the issue persists, reset network settings via **Settings > General > Transfer or Reset iPhone > Reset > Reset Network Settings**
- **App Crashing:** Close the app and reopen it. If it continues to crash, try deleting and reinstalling the app.
- **Battery Drain:** Review apps using significant battery in **Settings > Battery**. Adjust background app refresh or location services as needed.
- **Face ID Not Working:** Ensure your face is clear and well-lit. If issues persist, reset Face ID in **Settings > Face ID & Passcode**.

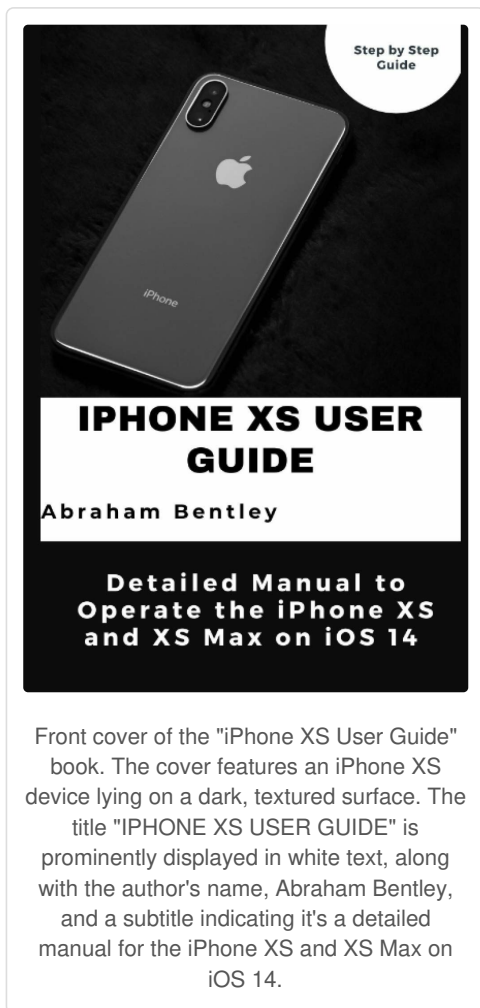
