INTRODUCTION

The Hyper Tough 300-Lumen LED Battery Spotlight is a powerful and versatile lighting tool designed for both indoor and outdoor use. Its ultra-bright LED provides ample illumination for various tasks, from automotive repairs to camping and emergency situations. Featuring a durable housing with a rubber cover, it offers 1-meter impact resistance. The ergonomic pistol-grip handle ensures a comfortable hold, while the locking pivoting stand and convenient trigger lock allow for hands-free operation. This spotlight is rechargeable via an included USB cord, making it a reliable companion for any situation requiring strong, portable light.

- Recharge only with the USB charging cable provided.
- Do not short-circuit the battery.
- Do not disassemble, open, or shred battery cells or packs.
- Store the spotlight in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and heat sources.

SETUP

Your Hyper Tough Spotlight comes with a built-in rechargeable Lithium-Ion battery. Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge the spotlight.

Charging the Spotlight

1. Locate the USB charging port on the spotlight.
2. Connect the small end of the included USB charging cable to the spotlight's charging port.
3. Connect the larger end of the USB charging cable to a standard USB power adapter (not included) or a powered USB port on a computer.
4. Allow the spotlight to charge until the charging indicator light (if present) indicates a full charge. A full charge typically takes approximately 3 hours.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Turning On/Off and Mode Selection

The spotlight features a convenient trigger-style power button and multiple light modes.

1. To turn the spotlight ON, press the trigger button located on the handle.
2. To cycle through the different light modes (e.g., High, Low, Strobe), press the trigger button repeatedly.
3. To turn the spotlight OFF, continue pressing the trigger button until the light turns off, or hold the button down for a few seconds.

Hands-Free Operation

The spotlight is equipped with a locking pivoting stand for stable, hands-free illumination.

1. Locate the pivoting stand at the base of the spotlight.
2. Extend the stand to your desired angle.
3. Ensure the stand is securely locked into position to prevent accidental movement.
4. Place the spotlight on a flat, stable surface to direct light where needed.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Wipe the spotlight with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Ensure the charging port is free of dust and debris.

Battery Care and Storage

- For optimal battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently.
- Recharge the spotlight regularly, even if not in use, to maintain battery health.
- Store the spotlight in a cool, dry place when not in use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution

Spotlight does not turn on.	Battery is fully discharged.	Charge the spotlight using the provided USB cable.
Spotlight does not charge.	Faulty USB cable or power adapter; charging port is dirty.	Try a different USB cable or power adapter. Clean the charging port gently.
Light output is dim.	Battery is low.	Recharge the spotlight.
