1. INTRODUCTION

The Baby Born Little Girl doll is designed for imaginative play, featuring seven lifelike functions. This manual provides instructions for the proper use and care of your 36cm Classic doll.

2. SETUP

2.1 Unboxing

Carefully remove the doll and all accessories from the packaging. Inspect the doll for any visible damage before first use.

2.2 Initial Preparation

No assembly is required for the doll. Ensure all accessories, such as the bottle and potty, are clean before use.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Baby Born Little Girl doll features seven interactive functions:

- Drinking water

- Wetting her nappy
- Crying tears
- Going to the potty
- Bathing
- Flexible arms and legs
- Closing eyes when laid down

3.1 Drinking Water

Fill the included bottle with clean water. Gently insert the bottle into the doll's mouth and tilt it upwards to allow the doll to drink. The doll will consume the water, which is necessary for other functions like wetting her nappy or crying tears.

3.2 Wetting Nappy and Potty Use

After the doll drinks water, she can wet her nappy or use the potty. To make her wet her nappy, ensure she is wearing a nappy. To use the potty, place her on the potty after she has consumed water. The water will pass through the doll.

3.3 Crying Tears

If the doll has recently drunk water, you can make her cry tears. Gently squeeze her upper body or head to activate the crying mechanism. Tears will emerge from her eyes.

3.4 Bathing

The Baby Born Little Girl doll is suitable for bathing. Ensure the doll is completely dry after bathing to prevent water retention. Do not use harsh soaps or chemicals.

3.5 Flexible Movement

The doll features flexible arms and legs, allowing for various poses and easy changing of clothes. Gently move the limbs to position the doll as desired.

3.6 Closing Eyes

When the doll is laid down on her back, her eyes will automatically close, simulating sleep. When she is upright, her eyes will open.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning the Doll

To clean the doll, wipe her surface with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the doll in water for extended periods, except during supervised bathing as described in section 3.4. Ensure all internal mechanisms are dry after water play.

4.2 Clothing Care

The doll's clothing can be hand-washed with mild detergent and air-dried. Avoid machine washing or tumble drying to preserve fabric quality.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Doll not drinking:** Ensure the bottle is properly inserted into the doll's mouth and tilted to allow water flow. Check for any blockages in the bottle's nipple.
- **Doll not wetting nappy/potty:** Confirm the doll has consumed sufficient water. The wetting function is directly linked to water intake.
- **Doll not crying tears:** Ensure the doll has recently drunk water. The tear mechanism requires water to be present in the doll's internal reservoir.
- **Eyes not closing:** Verify the doll is laid completely flat on her back. The eye-closing mechanism is gravity-activated.
