INTRODUCTION

The HARIO XRCN-2-B Glass Microwave Rice Pot is designed for convenient and efficient rice cooking in a microwave oven. This pot allows you to prepare 1 to 2 servings of rice, including various types of rice and seasonal cooked rice dishes. Its glass construction ensures no odor absorption and easy cleaning.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Always handle the glass pot with care, especially when hot. Use oven mitts or heat-resistant gloves.
- Ensure the pot is placed on a stable, heat-resistant surface after removing from the microwave.
- Do not use the pot on direct heat sources such as gas stoves or electric cooktops. It is designed exclusively for microwave use.
- Avoid sudden temperature changes, such as placing a hot pot directly into cold water, as this may cause the glass to crack.
- Keep out of reach of children.

SETUP

Unpacking and Initial Cleaning

1. Carefully remove all components from the packaging. The package includes the glass pot, lid, and original recipes.
2. Wash all parts (glass pot and lid) thoroughly with warm soapy water before first use. Rinse well and dry.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Cooking White Rice (1-2 Cups)

1. **Measure Rice:** Use the included measuring cup or a standard 1-cup (180ml) measuring cup. The pot is designed for 1 to 2 cups of uncooked rice.
2. **Wash Rice:** Rinse the rice thoroughly under cold running water until the water runs clear.
3. **Soak Rice:** Place the washed rice into the HARIO Glass Microwave Rice Pot. Add water according to the rice type and desired consistency. A general guideline for white rice is 1.2 to 1.5 cups of water per 1 cup of rice. For optimal results, soak the rice in water for 30 minutes to 1 hour before cooking.
4. **Cover:** Place the lid securely on the pot.
5. **Microwave Cooking:** Place the covered pot into your microwave oven. For 1 cup of white rice, microwave at 600W for approximately 10 minutes. For 2 cups, adjust cooking time as needed, typically 12-15 minutes. Cooking times may vary based on microwave wattage and rice type.
6. **Resting Period:** After microwaving, leave the pot inside the microwave oven with the lid on for an additional 10 to 15 minutes to allow the rice to steam and fully absorb moisture. This step is crucial for perfectly cooked rice.
7. **Serve:** Carefully remove the pot from the microwave using oven mitts. Fluff the rice with a paddle or fork before serving.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** The HARIO Glass Microwave Rice Pot and its lid are dishwasher safe. For hand washing, use a soft sponge and mild dish soap. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads that could scratch the glass.
- **Odor Absorption:** Due to its glass construction, the pot does not absorb odors, making it easy to clean and maintain freshness for various dishes.
- **Storage:** Store the pot in a dry place when not in use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Rice Overflow During Cooking

It is common for microwave rice cookers to experience some water boil-over, especially with certain rice types or microwave power settings. To mitigate this:

- **Use a Tray:** Place the rice pot on a microwave-safe plate or a wide, shallow bowl inside the microwave. This will catch any overflow and keep your microwave clean.
- **Adjust Water/Rice Ratio:** Experiment with slightly less water, especially if you consistently experience overflow.
- **Adjust Power/Time:** If your microwave is higher wattage, consider reducing the cooking time slightly or using a lower power setting for a longer duration.
