SAFETY INFORMATION

PACKAGE CONTENTS

SETUP

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging.
2. **Choose a Surface:** Select a large, flat, and stable surface for building your track.
3. **Lay Base Plates:** Arrange the hexagonal base plates to form the foundation of your track. These can be connected or placed separately.
4. **Add Height Tiles:** Place height tiles on the base plates to create elevation changes. Experiment with different heights to influence marble speed and direction.
5. **Connect Tracks:** Use the various track pieces (straight, curves) to connect the height tiles and create paths for the marbles. Ensure tracks are securely seated.
6. **Integrate Action Tiles:** Position action tiles (e.g., cannon, magnetic cannon) strategically to add dynamic elements to your run. Follow the specific instructions for each action tile.
7. **Test Your Design:** Before finalizing, test your track with a marble to identify any areas where the marble might stop or fall off. Adjust components as needed.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once your Gravitrax track is assembled, operating it is straightforward:

1. **Place Marbles:** Position one or more marbles at the designated starting points of your track.
2. **Release:** Gently release the marbles and observe their journey through the track.
3. **Observe and Adjust:** Pay attention to how gravity and the various track elements affect the marbles' speed and direction. If a marble gets stuck or deviates, adjust the track components to optimize the flow.
4. **Experiment:** Gravitrax encourages experimentation. Try different starting points, track configurations, and action tile placements to discover new possibilities and challenges.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe components with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, but ensure all parts are completely dry before storage. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store all Gravitrax components in their original packaging or a suitable container to prevent loss and damage. Keep them away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all parts for wear and tear. Discard any broken or damaged components to prevent injury.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Marble stops or slows down significantly.	Insufficient incline, friction, or misaligned track pieces.	Increase the height difference between sections. Ensure tracks are smoothly connected and free of debris. Check for any elements obstructing the marble's path.
Marble falls off the track.	Excessive speed, sharp turns, or unstable track structure.	Reduce the incline before sharp turns. Ensure all height tiles and tracks are firmly placed and stable. Add more base plates for a wider, more stable foundation.
Action tile not functioning correctly.	Incorrect placement, marble not reaching with enough force, or component malfunction.	Refer to the specific instructions for the action tile. Ensure the marble hits the trigger correctly and with sufficient momentum. Check for any obstructions.
