INTRODUCTION

The HP DeskJet 4155e is a versatile all-in-one wireless color inkjet printer designed for home use. It offers print, scan, and copy functionalities, along with mobile printing capabilities and an auto document feeder. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your printer.

SETUP

Unboxing and Initial Placement


Carefully remove the printer from its packaging. Ensure all protective tapes and materials are removed. Place the printer on a stable, flat surface.

Power Connection

Connect the power cord to the printer and then to a wall outlet. Do not connect the USB cable to your computer yet.

Ink Cartridge Installation

Open the ink cartridge access door. Wait for the print carriage to move to the center. Install the HP 67 Setup Black Cartridge and HP 67 Setup Tri-Color Cartridge into their respective slots. Close the access door.

Software Installation and Wireless Setup (HP Smart App)

Download the HP Smart app on your mobile device (smartphone or tablet) or computer. Follow the step-by-step guided setup within the app to connect your printer to your dual-band Wi-Fi network. The app facilitates mobile printing, security features, and automatic updates.

OPERATING THE PRINTER

Printing Documents

Load paper into the 60-sheet rear input tray. From your computer or mobile device, select the document or image you wish to print. Choose your HP DeskJet 4155e from the available printers and adjust print settings as needed (e.g., color, black and white, paper size). Initiate the print job.



Scanning Documents

Place the document face-down on the flatbed scanner glass or load multiple pages into the 35-sheet auto document feeder (ADF). Open the HP Smart app or scanning software on your computer. Select the scan function, choose your desired settings (e.g., resolution, file type), and start the scan.



Copying Documents

Place the original document on the scanner glass or in the ADF. On the printer's control panel, press the Copy button (usually indicated by a copy icon). Select the number of copies and whether you want color or black and white. Press the Start Copy button.

MAINTENANCE

Ink Cartridge Replacement

The HP DeskJet 4155e uses HP 67 ink cartridges. When ink levels are low, the HP Smart app can notify you, and with HP Instant Ink service, new cartridges can be delivered to your door before you run out. Always use original HP ink cartridges for optimal performance and to maintain printer warranty.




Image: An HP Instant Ink box containing black and tri-color ink cartridges, illustrating the ink delivery service.

Cleaning the Printer

Regularly clean the exterior of the printer with a soft, lint-free cloth. For print quality issues, refer to the HP Smart app or the printer's reference guide for instructions on cleaning printheads or aligning cartridges.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Connectivity Issues

If the printer loses Wi-Fi connection, ensure your router is working and the printer is within range. The dual-band Wi-Fi with self-reset feature is designed to automatically detect and resolve connectivity problems. For persistent issues, re-run the wireless setup through the HP Smart app.

Print Quality Problems

If prints are faded, streaky, or incorrect colors, check ink levels in the HP Smart app. Perform printhead cleaning and alignment procedures as instructed in the printer's software or documentation.

Paper Jams

If a paper jam occurs, carefully remove any jammed paper from the input tray, output tray, or inside the printer. Refer to the printer's reference guide for specific instructions on clearing paper jams.
