INTRODUCTION

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

SETUP GUIDE

1. Powering On the Camera

Connect the USB power supply to the camera and plug it into a power outlet. The camera will power on and initiate its self-test sequence.

2. App Installation

Download the "Wansview Cloud" app from your smartphone's app store (available on iOS and Android). Register for a new account or log in if you already have one.

3. Network Connection

The wansview W9 camera supports both Wi-Fi (2.4GHz only) and Ethernet connections.

Wi-Fi Connection:

- 1. Open the Wansview Cloud app and tap the "+" icon to add a new device.
- 2. Select your camera model (W9) and follow the on-screen instructions.
- 3. Ensure your phone is connected to a 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network. The camera does not support 5GHz Wi-Fi.
- 4. Scan the QR code displayed on your phone with the camera lens.
- 5. Wait for the camera to connect to your Wi-Fi network.

Ethernet Connection:

- 1. Connect an Ethernet cable from your router to the RJ45 port on the camera.
- 2. The camera will automatically connect to the network.
- 3. Follow the app instructions to add the camera to your account.

4. Mounting the Camera

The wansview W9 camera is designed for wall mounting and outdoor use (IP65 waterproof).

- 1. Choose a suitable location for installation, ensuring a clear view and stable mounting surface.
- 2. Use the provided mounting bracket set to securely attach the camera to the wall.
- 3. Adjust the camera's angle as needed after mounting.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Pan-Tilt Control

The camera features a 350° horizontal pan and 90° vertical tilt range, allowing you to monitor a wide area.

- In the Wansview Cloud app, access the live view of your camera.
- Use the directional controls on the screen to remotely adjust the camera's pan and tilt angles.

2. Night Vision

The camera is equipped with 12pcs 850nm infrared LED lights, providing clear night vision up to 50 feet.

- The camera automatically switches to night vision mode in low-light conditions.
- You can view the night vision feed in real-time through the Wansview Cloud app.

3. Two-Way Audio

Communicate with visitors or deter intruders using the built-in microphone and speaker.

- From the live view in the Wansview Cloud app, tap the microphone icon to speak.
- Tap the speaker icon to listen to audio from the camera's location.




Figure 7: Two-Way Audio in Action.

4. Motion Detection and Alerts

The camera uses motion sensors to detect activity and sends instant alerts to your phone.

- Customize sensor sensitivity and detection areas within the Wansview Cloud app.
- Receive 10-second video alerts when motion is detected.




Figure 9: Instant Detection and Alerts.

5. Storage Options (SD Card & Cloud)

The wansview W9 camera offers flexible storage solutions for recorded footage.

- **SD Card Storage:** Supports up to 128GB microSD cards. Insert the card into the TF card slot (refer to Figure 2). Recorded video and images can be stored locally for preview.
- Cloud Storage: Subscribe to the paid Cloud service via the Wansview Cloud app to save and upload videos securely to the cloud. This provides an additional layer of security against camera theft or damage.

6. Alexa Integration

Control your wansview W9 camera and view live feeds using Amazon Alexa.

- Enable the Wansview skill in the Alexa app.
- Link your Wansview Cloud account with Alexa.
- Use voice commands such as "Alexa, show me the [camera name]" to display the live video on compatible Alexa devices (e.g., Echo Show).

- Generate an invitation link within the Wansview Cloud app.
- · Share the link with family members to grant them access.

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Gently wipe the camera lens and body with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Firmware Updates:** Regularly check for and install firmware updates via the Wansview Cloud app to ensure optimal performance and security.
- Power Supply: Ensure the power supply is securely connected and free from damage.
- Network Connection: Verify a stable Wi-Fi or Ethernet connection for uninterrupted monitoring.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Camera offline	No power; Wi-Fi signal weak/disconnected; Router issue.	Check power connection; Move camera closer to router or use Ethernet; Restart router.
Cannot connect to Wi- Fi	Incorrect Wi-Fi password; Connecting to 5GHz network; Too far from router.	Double-check password; Ensure connection to 2.4GHz Wi-Fi; Relocate camera or router.
Motion alerts not received	Motion detection disabled; App notifications off; Sensitivity too low.	Enable motion detection in app; Check phone notification settings; Adjust sensitivity.
Poor night vision quality	Obstruction in front of lens; Infrared LEDs blocked.	Clear any obstructions; Ensure lens is clean.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Two-way audio issues	Microphone/speaker blocked; App permissions.	Ensure clear path for audio; Check app permissions for microphone.
