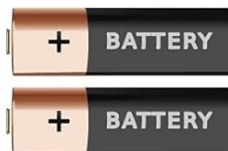

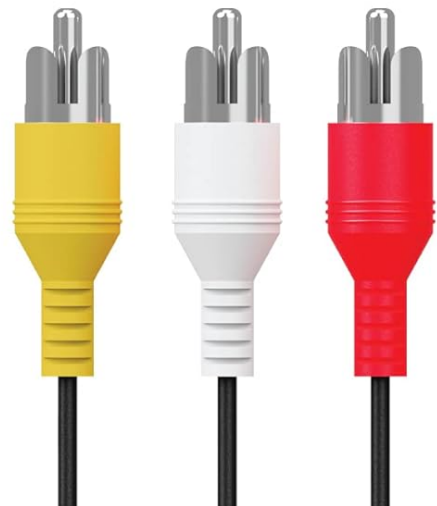

## SETUP GUIDE

---

### 1. Connecting to Your TV

The Oakcastle DVD100 offers multiple connection options to your television or display unit:

1. **HDMI Connection:** For the best audio and video quality, connect an HDMI cable (not included) from the HDMI OUT port on the DVD player to an HDMI IN port on your TV.
2. **RCA (Composite) Connection:** Use the provided RCA AV cable. Connect the yellow plug to the Video IN port on your TV, and the red and white plugs to the Audio R (Right) and Audio L (Left) IN ports respectively. Connect the other end to the corresponding ports on the DVD player.
3. **USB Connection:** The USB port on the front of the player allows for playback of media files from a USB drive.

### 2. Power Connection

Connect the provided mains power cable to the DC IN port on the back of the DVD player and then plug the other end into a standard wall outlet.

### 3. Inserting Batteries into the Remote Control

Open the battery compartment on the back of the remote control and insert the two AAA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-). Close the compartment securely.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Disc Playback

The DVD100 is compatible with a wide range of discs, including DVD, DVD+R/+RW, DVD-R/RW, CD, CD-MP3, CD+RW, and CD-R. It is also a multi-region (region-free) DVD player, allowing playback of DVDs from all regions and zones.

1. Ensure the DVD player is connected to your TV and powered on.
2. Press the "Open/Close" button on the player or remote to open the disc tray.
3. Place a compatible disc gently onto the disc tray with the label side facing up.
4. Press the "Open/Close" button again to close the disc tray.
5. The player will automatically load the disc and begin playback. If a menu appears, use the remote control's navigation buttons to select your desired option.

### USB Playback

The DVD100 supports playback of MP3 files and other media from a USB drive.

1. Insert your USB drive into the USB port on the front of the DVD player.
2. The player should automatically detect the USB drive and display its contents.
3. Use the remote control's navigation buttons to browse and select the desired file for playback.

# EASY TO USE CONTROLS

## Remote Control Functions

The included remote control provides full functionality for navigating menus, controlling playback, and accessing various settings. Key functions include:

- **Power:** Turns the player on or off.
- **Play/Pause:** Starts or pauses playback.
- **Stop:** Stops playback.
- **Fast Forward/Rewind:** Skips through content quickly.
- **Next/Previous:** Jumps to the next or previous track/chapter.
- **Navigation Buttons (Up, Down, Left, Right, OK):** For menu navigation and selection.
- **Setup:** Accesses the system settings menu.
- **Slow Motion:** Plays content in slow motion.
- **Zoom:** Zooms in on the picture.

*Tip:* Familiarize yourself with the remote's layout for seamless operation. The "Setup" button is crucial for adjusting display settings like aspect ratio.

## MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Oakcastle DVD100, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the exterior of the player. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive chemicals.
- **Disc Care:** Handle discs by their edges. Keep them clean and free of dust, fingerprints, and scratches. Store discs in their cases when not in use.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the player is placed in a well-ventilated area. Do not block the ventilation openings.
- **Storage:** If storing the player for an extended period, disconnect it from the power outlet and store it in a cool, dry place.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Oakcastle DVD100, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause / Solution
No power	Ensure the power cable is securely connected to both the player and the wall outlet. Check if the wall outlet is functioning by plugging in another device.
No picture or sound	Verify that the HDMI or RCA cables are correctly connected to both the player and the TV. Ensure your TV input/source is set to the correct HDMI or AV input. Check the volume level on your TV and the DVD player.
Disc does not play / "Region Not Supported" error	Ensure the disc is clean and free of scratches. Verify the disc type is compatible (DVD, CD, etc.). While the DVD100 is multi-region, some discs may still present issues. Try a different disc to confirm. Ensure the disc is inserted correctly with the label side up.
Picture looks stretched or compressed (incorrect aspect ratio)	Access the player's "Setup" menu using the remote control. Navigate to display settings and adjust the aspect ratio (e.g., 16:9 for widescreen TVs, or try other options if the content is older).
Remote control not working	Check if the batteries are inserted correctly and are not depleted. Replace if necessary. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the player's IR sensor. Point the remote directly at the player.

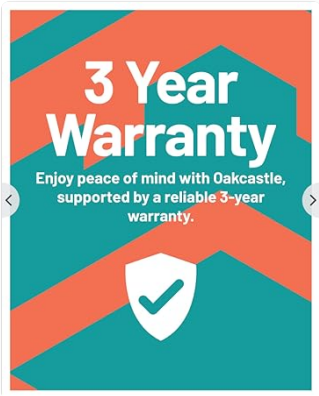
