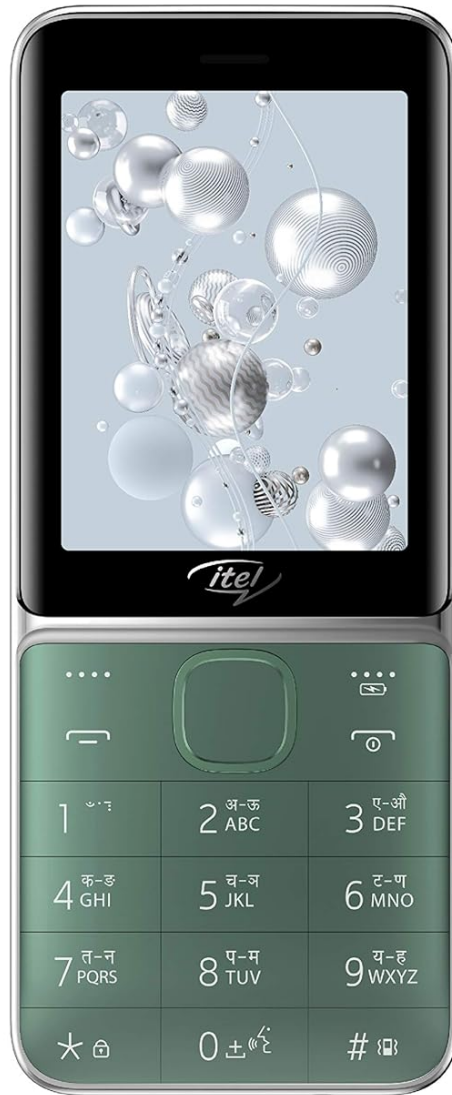


Figure 4.1: Front view of the itel it5626 mobile phone, showcasing the display and keypad.

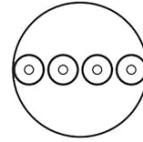

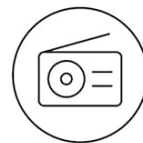

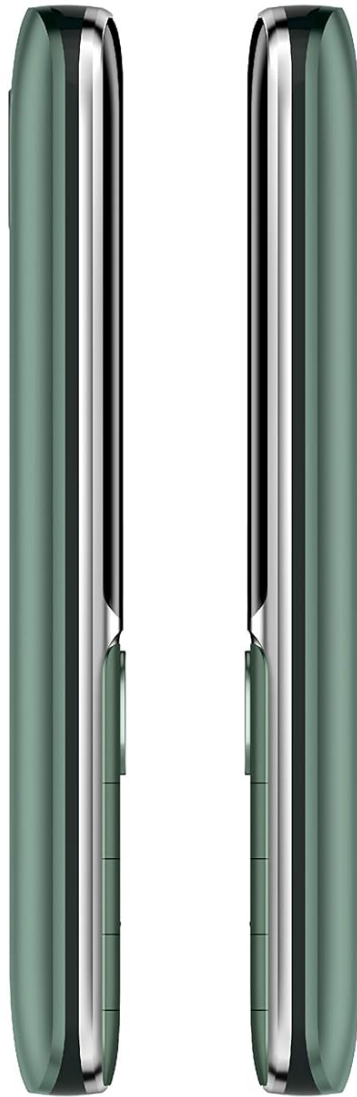


Figure 4.4: Side view of the itel it5626 mobile phone, highlighting its slim profile and metallic finish.

5. SETUP

5.1. Battery Installation

1. Remove the back cover of the phone by gently prying it open from the designated notch.
2. Align the gold contacts of the 2500mAh Lithium Ion battery with the contacts in the phone's battery compartment.
3. Gently press the battery into place.
4. Replace the back cover, ensuring it clicks securely into position.

5.2. SIM Card Installation

The itel it5626 supports multiple SIM cards. Follow these steps to insert your SIM card(s):

1. With the back cover and battery removed, locate the SIM card slot(s).
2. Insert your SIM card(s) into the slot(s) with the gold contacts facing down and the cut corner aligned as indicated on

the phone.

3. Ensure the SIM card(s) are fully seated.

5.3. Memory Card Installation (Optional)

To expand storage for photos, music, and other files, you can install a memory card (MicroSD card).

1. With the back cover and battery removed, locate the memory card slot.
2. Insert the memory card into the slot with the gold contacts facing down until it clicks into place.
3. To remove, gently push the card in until it springs out.

5.4. Charging the Battery

1. Connect the charger to the charging port on your phone.
2. Plug the charger into a power outlet.
3. The battery indicator on the screen will show the charging status.
4. Once fully charged, disconnect the charger.

6. OPERATING THE DEVICE

6.1. Power On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power/End Call key until the screen lights up.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power/End Call key until the power-off options appear, then select 'Power off'.

6.2. Making and Receiving Calls

- **Making a Call:** Enter the phone number using the keypad and press the Call key (green button).
- **Receiving a Call:** When a call comes in, press the Call key (green button) to answer.
- **Ending a Call:** Press the Power/End Call key (red button) to end a call.

6.3. Sending and Receiving Messages

- Navigate to the 'Messages' menu.
- Select 'Write message' to compose a new SMS.
- Enter the recipient's number or select from contacts.
- Type your message and send.

6.4. Kingvoice Feature

The Kingvoice feature provides voice assistance for various phone functions, enhancing accessibility. To activate or use Kingvoice, navigate to the 'Settings' menu and look for 'Kingvoice' options, or refer to the phone's on-screen prompts.

6.5. Wireless FM Radio

Your itel it5626 includes a Wireless FM radio with recording capability.

- Access the 'FM Radio' application from the main menu.
- Use the navigation keys to scan for stations.
- To record FM content, select the record option within the FM application.

6.6. Bluetooth Connectivity

The phone supports Bluetooth for wireless connection to other devices.

1. Go to 'Settings' > 'Connectivity' > 'Bluetooth'.
2. Turn Bluetooth on.
3. Search for available devices and pair with your desired device.

6.7. Quad LED Torch

To activate the Quad LED Torch, typically press and hold a dedicated key on the keypad or access it through the shortcuts menu. Refer to your phone's specific key assignments.

6.8. Language Settings

The itel it5626 supports 8 input languages. To change the language:

1. Go to 'Settings' > 'Phone settings' > 'Language'.
2. Select your preferred language from the list.

6.9. Auto Call Recorder

The phone features an auto call recorder. To manage this function:

1. Navigate to 'Settings' or 'Call Settings'.
2. Locate the 'Auto Call Record' option and enable or disable it as needed.

7. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the phone's screen and body. Avoid liquid cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the phone in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Battery Care:** Do not leave the battery fully discharged or fully charged for extended periods. Charge the battery regularly.
- **Software Updates:** Keep your phone's software updated if updates become available, to ensure optimal performance and security.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your itel it5626, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
Phone does not power on	Ensure the battery is correctly installed and charged. Try charging the phone for at least 30 minutes.
No network signal	Check if the SIM card is properly inserted. Ensure you are in an area with network coverage. Restart the phone.
Cannot make or receive calls	Verify network signal. Check if call barring or call forwarding is enabled. Ensure sufficient balance on your SIM card.
Battery drains quickly	Reduce screen brightness. Close unused applications. Limit use of features like Bluetooth when not needed.
Keypad unresponsive	Restart the phone. Ensure no physical obstruction or damage to the keypad.
