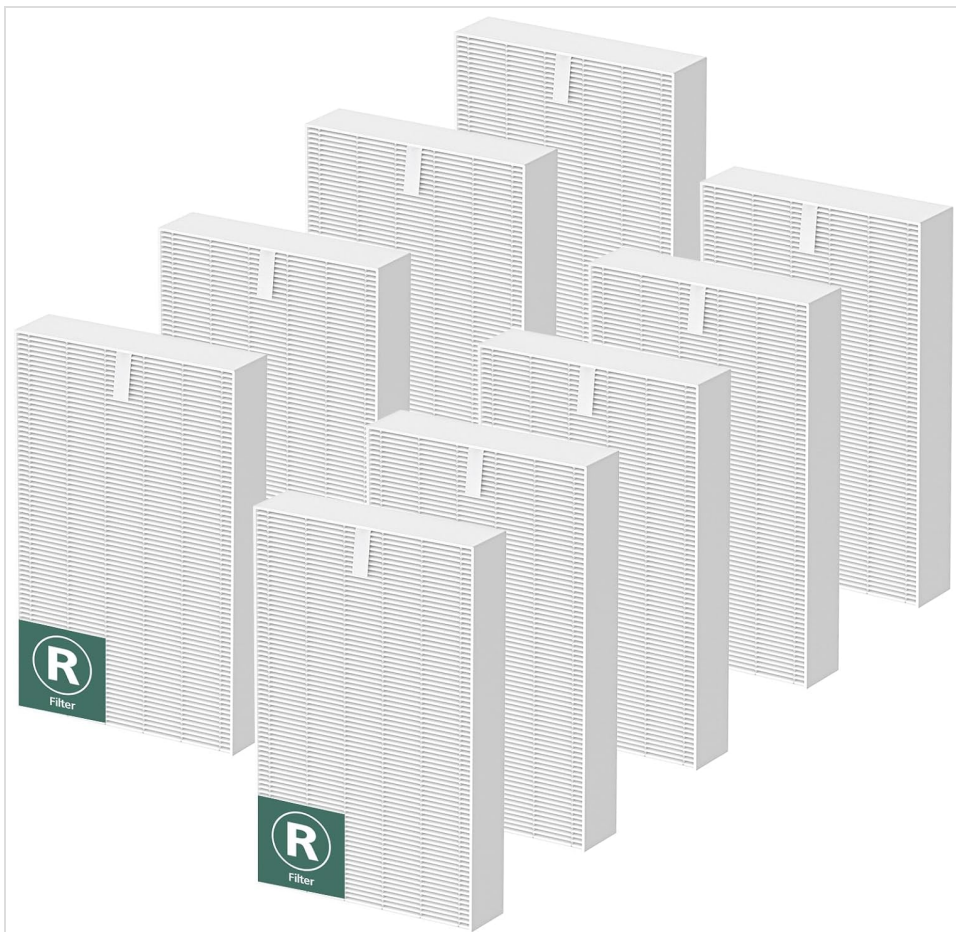

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper installation and maintenance of your Cabiclean HPA300 HEPA Air Purifier Filter R replacements. These filters are designed to be compatible with various Honeywell HPA series air purifiers, ensuring continued air purification performance.

- **Compatibility:** Direct replacement for Honeywell R Filter Part # HRF-R3, HRF-R2, and HRF-R1.

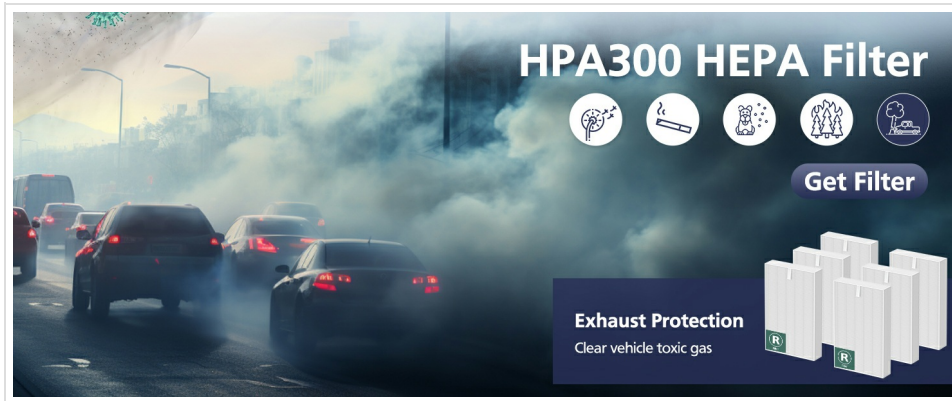


Image 2.1: Efficient Filtration Process (Note: Activated Carbon Filter is not included with this product)

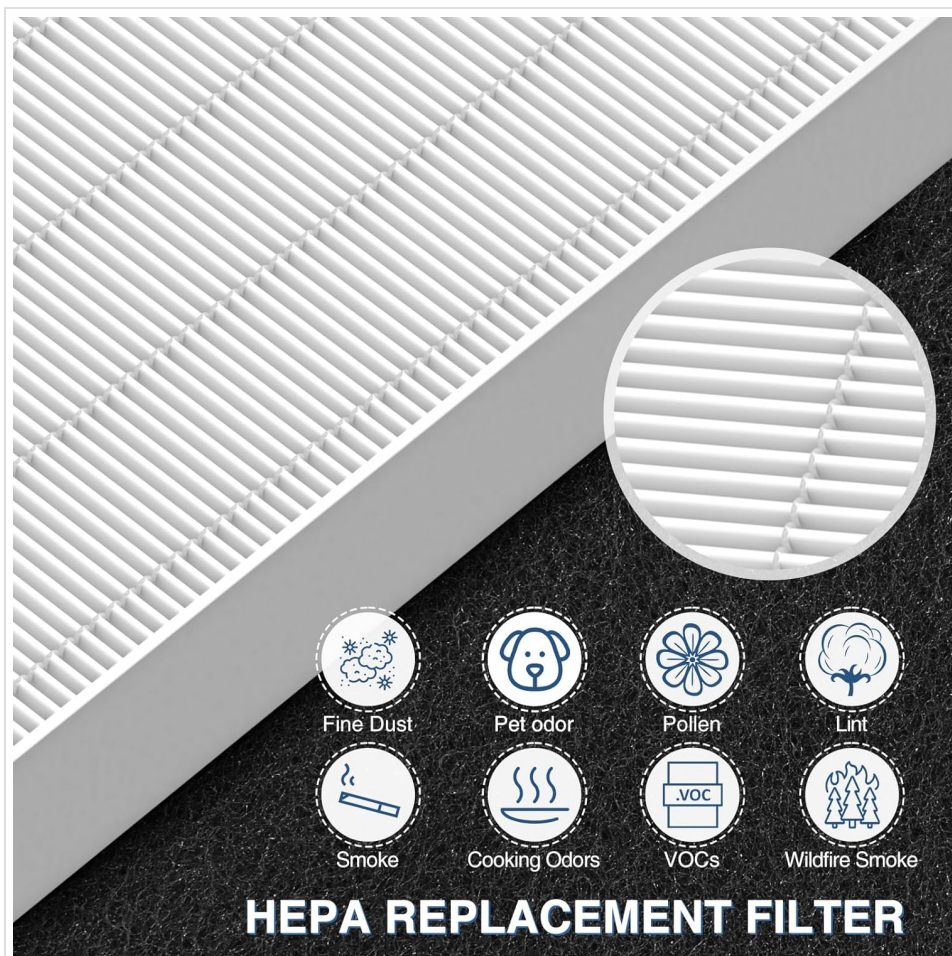


Image 2.2: Types of Particles Filtered by HEPA Replacement Filter

3. COMPATIBILITY

These Cabiclean HPA300 HEPA Filter R replacements are compatible with the following Honeywell Air Purifier models:

- HPA5100, HPA5150, HPA5200, HPA5220, HPA5250, HPA5300, HPA5350, HPA8350

This filter replaces Honeywell R Filter Part # HRF-R3, HRF-R2, and HRF-R1.

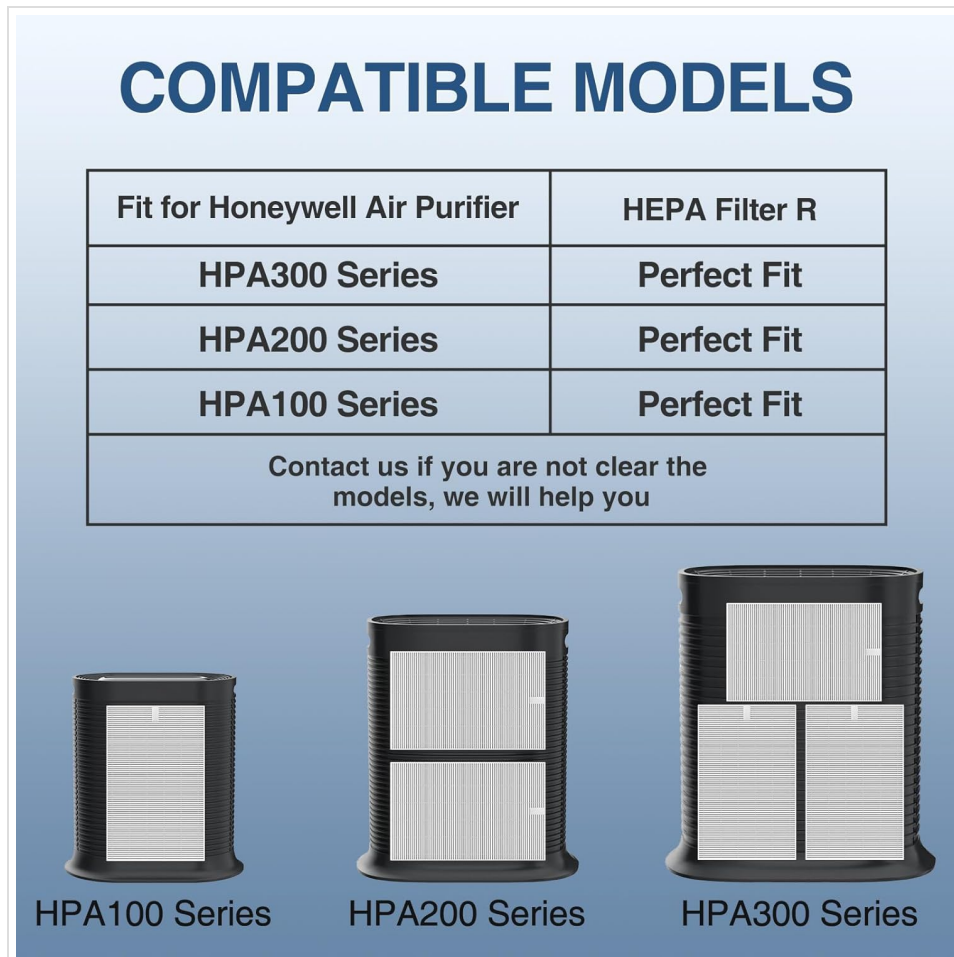


Image 3.1: Visual Guide to Compatible Honeywell Air Purifier Series

4. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Your package includes:

- 9 x HEPA Filter R Replacement

Note: Activated Carbon Pre-Filters are not included in this package.

5. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Replacing the HEPA filters in your compatible Honeywell air purifier is a straightforward process that requires no special tools.

1. **Power Off:** Ensure your air purifier is turned off and unplugged from the power outlet before beginning the replacement process.

2. **Access Filter Compartment:** Refer to your specific Honeywell air purifier model's user manual for instructions on how to open the filter compartment. This typically involves removing the front grille or cover.
3. **Remove Old Filters:** Carefully remove the used HEPA R filters from their slots. Dispose of them according to local regulations.
4. **Insert New Filters:** Unpack the new Cabiclean HEPA Filter R replacements. Insert them into the designated slots, ensuring they are oriented correctly (follow any arrows or indicators on the filter or purifier).
5. **Close Compartment:** Securely close the filter compartment cover or grille.
6. **Restore Power:** Plug the air purifier back into the power outlet and turn it on.
7. **Reset Filter Indicator (if applicable):** If your air purifier has a filter replacement indicator light, follow your purifier's instructions to reset it.

6. MAINTENANCE AND REPLACEMENT SCHEDULE

For optimal performance and air quality, it is recommended to replace the HEPA Filter R every 6 to 12 months. The actual replacement frequency may vary depending on your air purifier's usage, environmental conditions, and the presence of pets or allergens.

Regular replacement ensures that your air purifier continues to effectively capture airborne particles and maintain a clean breathing environment.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues after replacing your filters, consider the following:

- **Reduced Airflow:** Ensure the filters are installed correctly and the filter compartment is securely closed. Check for any obstructions around the air intake or output vents of the purifier.
- **Persistent Odors:** While HEPA filters capture particles, they do not primarily remove odors. If odors persist, ensure you are also using an activated carbon pre-filter (sold separately) in your air purifier, and check its replacement schedule.
- **Filter Indicator Light Remains On:** Consult your air purifier's manual for specific instructions on how to reset the filter change indicator after installing new filters. This often involves pressing and holding a button for a few seconds.
- **Unusual Noise:** Verify that the filters are seated properly and not vibrating within the compartment.
