1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Dolphin Wave 100 Robotic Pool Vacuum Cleaner. The Dolphin Wave 100 is designed for commercial pools up to 88 feet in length, offering comprehensive cleaning of the pool floor, walls, and waterline. It features a remote control for manual navigation and a caddy for convenient transport and storage.

Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure optimal performance and longevity.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always observe the following safety precautions to reduce the risk of injury or damage to the product:

- Ensure the power supply is disconnected from the electrical outlet before performing any maintenance or cleaning tasks.
- Do not operate the cleaner if the power cable is damaged. Contact authorized service personnel for repair.
- Keep children and pets away from the pool area while the cleaner is in operation.
- Only use the power supply provided with the Dolphin Wave 100.
- Do not enter the pool while the cleaner is operating.
- Store the cleaner and power supply in a dry, shaded area when not in use.
- Avoid operating the cleaner in water temperatures outside the recommended range (typically 43-93°F / 6-34°C).

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present in the package:

- Dolphin Wave 100 Robotic Pool Cleaner Unit
- Power Supply Unit
- Remote Control

- Caddy for Transport and Storage
- Filter Bags (Fine and Ultra-Fine options)

4. SETUP

4.1 Unpacking and Caddy Assembly

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Assemble the caddy according to the included instructions. The caddy facilitates easy transport and storage of the cleaner and its cable.

4.2 Connecting the Power Supply

1. Place the power supply unit at least 10 feet (3 meters) from the edge of the pool.
2. Connect the floating cable from the cleaner to the power supply unit. Ensure the connection is secure.
3. Plug the power supply into a grounded electrical outlet.

4.3 Placing the Cleaner in the Pool

Gently lower the Dolphin Wave 100 into the pool. Allow it to sink to the bottom. Ensure there are no air bubbles trapped inside the cleaner before starting operation.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Starting a Cleaning Cycle

Press the ON/OFF button on the power supply unit to begin a cleaning cycle. The cleaner will automatically start its programmed cleaning routine.

5.2 Using the Remote Control

The remote control allows for manual steering and selection of cleaning modes. Refer to the remote control's specific instructions for detailed usage.

5.3 Cleaning Modes

The Dolphin Wave 100 offers various cleaning modes to suit different needs:

- **Quick Clean:** For rapid cleaning when time is limited.
- **Standard Clean:** A balanced cleaning cycle for regular maintenance.
- **Enhanced Clean:** A thorough cleaning cycle, ideal for heavily soiled pools, with cleaning times up to eight hours.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Dolphin Wave 100.

6.1 Filter Cleaning

The Wave 100 features bottom-load filter access. The full filter indicator will signal when cleaning is required. Interchangeable fine and ultra-fine filter options are available to capture various debris sizes.

1. Disconnect the power supply before cleaning.
2. Access the filter compartment from the bottom of the cleaner.
3. Remove the filter bags/cartridges.
4. Rinse the filter bags thoroughly with a hose until all debris is removed.
5. Reinsert the clean filter bags/cartridges and secure the compartment.

6.3 General Product Care

- Regularly clean the filter.
- Rinse debris off the robot after each use.
- Periodically check for any damage to the cleaner or cable.
- Store the unit in a dry, shaded place when not in use.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Dolphin Wave 100, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cleaner does not start or stops during operation.	Power supply disconnected, filter clogged, or internal fault.	Check power connections. Clean the filter bags. If the problem persists, contact customer support.
Poor cleaning performance or missed areas.	Clogged filter, worn brushes, or incorrect cleaning mode.	Clean filter bags. Inspect brushes for wear and replace if necessary. Select an appropriate cleaning mode (e.g., Enhanced).
Cleaner does not climb walls or scrub waterline effectively.	Worn brushes, excessive algae, or water chemistry issues.	Inspect and replace brushes if worn. Balance pool chemistry. Manually scrub heavy algae before cleaner use.
Remote control not responding.	Remote batteries low, obstruction, or communication issue.	Replace remote batteries. Ensure clear line of sight to the cleaner. Restart the power supply unit.
Debris re-enters pool when removing cleaner.	Filter bags not fully sealed or cleaner lifted too quickly.	Ensure filter bags are correctly installed and sealed. Lift the cleaner slowly and allow water to drain completely using the quick water release feature.
