INSTALLATION GUIDE

Professional installation is recommended for optimal performance and to ensure compliance with local plumbing codes. The following steps provide a general overview.

2. **Install the Valve Body:** Secure the valve body within the wall according to the rough-in dimensions. Ensure it is level and properly aligned with the finished wall surface.
