1. INTRODUCTION AND OVERVIEW

The EPOS I SENNHEISER Adapt 160 USB II is an on-ear, double-sided USB headset designed for unified communications (UC) professionals. It offers in-line call control and superior stereo sound, making it ideal for the demands of today's hybrid workplace. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your headset, ensuring optimal performance and comfort.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon opening your package, please verify that all components are present:

- EPOS | SENNHEISER Adapt 160 USB II Headset with integrated USB-A cable and in-line call control.

3. SETUP

3.1 Connecting Your Headset

- USB-A Connection:** Plug the USB-A connector of the headset into an available USB-A port on your computer (laptop or desktop).
- 3.5 mm Jack Option:** If your model includes a 3.5 mm jack option, you can connect it to compatible devices.
- Driver Installation:** The headset is typically plug-and-play. Your operating system should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers. Allow a few moments for this process to complete.
- Audio Settings:** After connection, verify that the EPOS I SENNHEISER Adapt 160 USB II is selected as the default audio input and output device in your computer's sound settings.

3.2 Adjusting for Comfort

- Adjust the headband to ensure a comfortable and secure fit on your head.
- Position the ear pads over your ears. The headset features large on-ear leatherette or foam ear pads for comfort and noise dampening.
- Rotate the pivoting boom arm to position the microphone approximately 1-2 inches from your mouth for optimal voice pickup.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 In-line Call Control

The headset features an intuitive in-line control unit for managing calls and audio:

- Answer/End Call:** Press the call button (usually indicated by a phone icon) to answer or end a call.
- Volume Up/Down:** Use the '+' and '-' buttons to adjust the listening volume.
- Microphone Mute:** Press the microphone icon button to mute or unmute your microphone. An indicator light on the control unit may show the mute status.

4.2 Microphone Usage

- The integrated microphone is designed for clear voice pickup. Ensure it is positioned correctly in front of your mouth.
- When not in use, the pivoting boom arm can be folded discreetly into the headband for convenience and protection.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your headset, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **No Sound/Microphone Not Working:**

- Ensure the headset is securely plugged into the USB-A port.
- Check your computer's sound settings to confirm the headset is selected as the default playback and recording device.
- Verify that the microphone is not muted via the in-line control or your software settings.
- Try plugging the headset into a different USB port.

- **Poor Audio Quality:**

- Ensure the microphone is positioned correctly near your mouth.
- Check for background noise in your environment. The ear pads provide some noise dampening.
- Update your computer's audio drivers.

- **In-line Controls Not Responding:**

- Ensure the headset is properly connected.
- Restart the application you are using (e.g., communication software).
- Try restarting your computer.
