INTRODUCTION

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice not dispensing	Control rod is bent or obstructed.	Disconnect power, inspect the rod for damage or obstructions. Clear any blockages or replace the rod if bent.
Rod does not move freely	Ice buildup or foreign object.	Disconnect power, remove ice bin, and clear any ice or debris around the rod's pivot points.
Unusual noise during dispensing	Rod misaligned or rubbing against components.	Disconnect power, check the rod's seating and alignment. Ensure it is not touching other parts incorrectly.
