# Aigostar Electric Coffee Grinder Instruction Manual

## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your Aigostar Electric Coffee Grinder. Please read all instructions carefully before first use and retain this manual for future reference.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Always ensure the power supply matches the voltage specified on the appliance.
- Disconnect the power supply before disassembling, assembling, or adjusting any part of the product.
- If the power cord is damaged, contact customer service. Do not disassemble or repair the appliance yourself.
- This product is only suitable for grinding dry ingredients. Do not grind meat, vegetables, or fruits such as apples.
- Do not exceed the maximum cup volume.
- The maximum continuous working time is 60 seconds. Allow the appliance to cool down for 60 seconds between uses. Stop using for 5 minutes after 3 continuous uses.
- Ensure the grinding bowl and cover are firmly locked in place before operation to activate the safety micro-switch.
- Keep out of reach of children.

## PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Familiarize yourself with the parts of your Aigostar Electric Coffee Grinder:

- **Motor Unit:** The main body containing the motor and power button.
- **Removable Grinding Bowl:** Stainless steel bowl with integrated blades for grinding.
- **PP Lid:** Inner lid for the grinding bowl.
- **Transparent Lid:** Outer lid that covers the grinding bowl and activates the safety switch.
- **One-Touch Button:** For operating the grinder.
- **2-in-1 Spoon & Brush:** For measuring and cleaning.

## SETUP AND OPERATION

1. **Place Grinding Bowl:** Insert the removable grinding bowl into the motor unit, ensuring it is securely seated.
2. **Add Ingredients:** Use the provided spoon to add coffee beans, spices, herbs, or grains into the grinding bowl. Do not fill past the 'MAX' line.
3. **Secure Lids:** Place the PP lid over the grinding bowl, then position the transparent lid. Turn the transparent lid clockwise until it locks into place. This action activates the safety switch, allowing the grinder to operate.
4. **Grind:** Plug in the power cord. Press and hold the one-touch button to begin grinding. Release the button to stop.
5. **Check Fineness:** Observe the grinding process through the transparent lid. Grind for longer durations for finer results.
6. **Serve:** Once the desired fineness is achieved, unplug the grinder, unlock and remove the transparent lid, then remove the grinding bowl to pour out the ground contents.

# Dual Security Lock



*Only works when the base and lid are locked*

*(Only when the white rubber piece is pressed down by the cover will the micro switch be activated)*

## GRINDING GUIDE

The grinding time determines the fineness of your grind. Adjust according to your preferred brewing method:

- **French Press:** 5-10 seconds (coarse grind)
- **Drip Coffee:** 10-15 seconds (medium grind)
- **Espresso:** 15-20 seconds (fine grind)



## Customize Fineness & Coarseness

- Spices
- Herbs
- Grains (e.g., flaxseed)

## CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your grinder.

1. **Unplug:** Always unplug the appliance from the power outlet before cleaning.
2. **Remove Grinding Bowl:** Unlock and remove the transparent lid, then lift out the removable stainless steel grinding bowl.
3. **Clean Bowl:** The removable bowl can be easily washed with water. Use the provided 2-in-1 spoon and brush to remove any residual grounds from the blades and interior of the bowl. Ensure the bowl is completely dry before reassembling.
4. **Clean Motor Unit:** Wipe the exterior of the motor unit with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the motor unit in water or any other liquid.
5. **Reassemble:** Once all parts are clean and dry, reassemble the grinder by placing the grinding bowl back into the motor unit, followed by the PP lid and transparent lid, ensuring it is locked.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If your Aigostar Electric Coffee Grinder does not work, please follow these steps:

1. **Check Lids:** Ensure both the PP plastic cover and the transparent cover are tightly closed and correctly aligned.
2. **Lock Grinding Bowl:** Verify that the grinding bowl is firmly locked into position within the motor unit.
3. **Activate Micro Switch:** The transparent lid has grooves that must align with a white plastic micro-switch on the base. Turn the transparent lid clockwise until it presses down on this white plastic piece, activating the micro-switch. If it's not pressed down, the device will not work. If the white plastic piece is not pressed down, pick up the lid, rotate it slightly, and try again until the white plastic piece is pressed down.
